## SOLAR POWER

Using energy from the sun is one of the most popular forms of renewable energy that significantly reduces our carbon footprint. Since June 2015 we have had a 100kW solar system operating at our Murwillumbah brewery, which has mitigated CO2 emissions to the equivalent of planting 5000 trees.
