JAPANESE BROWN LACQUER AND INLAID NACREOUS LOW TABLE

the rectangular slightly inset top with notched corners, over cloud bracket front and rear apron, flanked by foliate cartouche side aprons, raised on slender cabriole legs with central ridge, ending in half scroll feet; the whole enriched with nacreous inlay, the top with fan, circle and foliate cartouches enclosing children at play, floral and foliate sprays, all within thin border, the sides with foliate and floral sprays with bird and cloud patterns, the legs similarly inlaid

16th - 17th Century - Edo Period - low tables like this one would have been placed in front of the central image in a Buddhist temple. Implements such as an incense burner, bowls, candle stands, and offerings of flowers would be arrayed across its surface
