the rectangular top with bowed front and knife edge with conforming inset "Yellow Lamertine" marble reserve, "floating": over conforming pierced straight apron, incorporating two short felt lined flush drawers centering brass ring handles; the whole raised on transitionally square section to round section tapering legs and feet

Designed by John Monteith "Jack" Gates - Architect – (1905-1979)

Director of Design for Corning Glass Works, and the first Managing Director of Steuben Glass beginning in 1933. A Life Fellow and a Benjamin Franklin Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts, London. A member of the American Institute of Architects and of the Industrial Designers of America.
