CHINESE BRONZE AND INLAYED GILT LAMP

in the form of a fully realized standing goose, with its head turned back and grasping a fish in its mouth, contiguous with circular section pierced and rotating shade fitted with a handle and resting on its back; the whole enriched with inlaid stylized swirling wings, feathers, crest and scales, retaining traces of archeological patination

After the Western Dynasty model (202 B.C. - 8 B.C.E.)
A similar model was excavated in 1985 from Pingshou, Shanxi Province – now in the National Museum of China, Beijing
