CHINESE STONE VESSEL

of circular deep dish form with tapering sides with incised bands at the shoulders and contiguously carved and moulded ram's heads on three sides, rising to Scotia moulded flaring rim, ending in flat base; the whole retaining traces of possible polychrome finish

Possibly Han Dynasty (206 B.C.E. - 220 CE)

Overall dimensions: 5 1/2" diameter x 4" high
