PAIR FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT OAK SLANT-BACK SIDE CHAIRS

each with planar construction and strict geometric elements adhering to the principals of his Prairie School style architecture with diagonal rectangular section back panels, flanked by square section legs, surmounted by conforming block finials and contiguous with back foot, joined to upholstered slipseat over conforming apron; the whole raised on square section front legs joined by similar stretchers

Frank Lloyd Wright used variations of the Slant-back chair in many projects throughout his career, including : Hillside Home School, Spring Green, WI; Little House, Peoria, IL; Unity Temple, Oak Park, IL; Larking Administration Building, Buffalo, NY.
