Boasting a powerful, heady bouquet with cassis, crushed black-cherry skins, baking spices along with a strong, wild, herbal note, and milk chocolate oak characters. Full-bodied, tasty, powerfully-structured wine with rich, mouth-filling tannin but plenty of fruit weight, savoury complexity, and a long finish. A classically structured wine that should deliver much drinking pleasure for years to come.

Our Thoughts:

Wow, beautiful. An intense, powerful, luxurious wine on the nose with ripe, dark, cherry fruit, haunting whole-bunch/undergrowth herbal complexity, and opulent creamy, vanilla oak all adding to the mix. A rich, powerfully structured, statement wine with a core of sappy, concentrated pinot-stem richness, and layers of flavour. The firm, chewy, mouth-coating tannins ,and dark chocolate, toasty, vanilla oak characters will need time to soften, and integrate but this wine seems to have it all.

Boasting a very intense, funky, complex, sulphide-influenced nose with lifted, wild berry, coffee bean, and smoky fire ember aromas. A potent, structured wine with rich, powerful mouth-filling tannins. It's clearly very youthful and needs time in the bottle but the level of concentration and the way the wine opens up in the glass suggest it's all there for the long haul.
