





1. Disconnect the ALICE shoulder straps from the 2. Orient the Carry Handle so the metal slider is 3. Slide the angle-cut end through the metal top of the frame. While the Carry Handle can be facing upward. Route the angle-cut end of the slider. attached with the pack still on the frame, it is Carry Handle through the shoulder strap slot at the top of the frame.










end, walk the metal slider towards the frame until against the frame, just snug, as shown above. reasonably snug.


4. Grabbing the metal slider and angle-cut strap 5. The Carry Handle does not need to be tight

6. Repeat steps 1-4 for the other side of the Carry Handle. Ensure the Carry Handle isn't twisted between the two frame slots.









7. Slide the angle-cut strap end over and back 8. Snug the angle-cut end tightly. through the metal slider, doubling the strap back on itself to eliminate the possibility of slippage.

Repeat steps 7-8 on the other side of the Carry Handle.

9. Connect the ALICE shoulder straps to the metal oval rings on the Carry Handle, in the same manner as if attaching them to the ALICE frame.





10. If desired, the free ends of the upper shoulder strap adjustment straps can be routed back through the metal oval rings. This will position them out of the way, behind the ALICE pack frame pocket once the pack is attached.
