AFTER 37 years of trading from their shop in London, the folk art specialist **Robert Young Antiques** will close temporarily for a renovation.

The premises at 68 Battersea Bridge Road will close on the evening of Saturday, February 7, and reopen at the beginning of May, celebrating with a preview party for the *Annual Exhibition of Folk Art* on May 7.

Robert will also host a BADA sponsored 'Masterclass' on British Folk Art during the exhibition at 2.30pm on May 13.

In the meantime, RYA will update clients with new acquisitions and progress via their website and social media.
