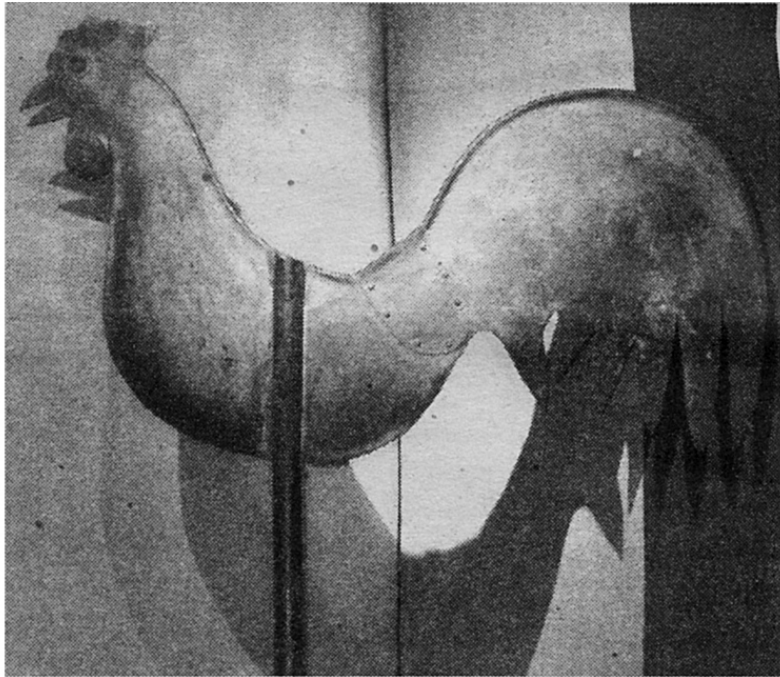


New York City

The Winter Antiques Show, 2010

Dealers pulled out all the stops, and the word got out. Attendance was up 17% by Thursday, and by Sunday the numbers for 2010 were 20% higher than in 2009, a low year in the show's history. Dealers said there was real interest and excitement about buying again.



Robert Young Antiques, London, England, asked \$8500 for this stylized cockerel weathervane cut from a thick sheet of copper with iron details. It's English, circa 1850, 33" high x 25" wide x 8³/₄" deep, and included the stand. It sold, as did more than half of the English and Continental folk art pictured in his catalog.
