MASSIMO DE CARLO vspace.massimodecarlo.com Ace in Milan: for the 'Risorgimento Virtual Art Summer', this new platform hosts five of the city's galleries from 9 June to 16 August.

MMK FRANKFURT mmk.art A retrospective of the paintings of Antiguan artist Frank Walter (1926-2009) embraces work by other artists who address the legacy of Caribbean colonialism. Not in Frankfurt? Download the booklet, or order the richly illustrated catalogue.

MUSEE INGRES BOURDELLE museeingresbourdelle.com Expanded and rebranded to honour both of Montauban's artistic exports, this museum reopened last December before having to close again in March. It's back up and running (at weekends) with a loan exhibition on the pair's associates and acolytes, including paintings by Ingres's pupils Amaury Duval and Lehmann, and sculptures by Rodin.

MUSEO PICASSO MALAGA museopicassomalaga.org Tune into the audio guide to an exhibition on art-historical groupings, genealogies and diagrams, with works by Cézanne, Gris, Miró; or listen to a playlist of songs that pay homage to Picasso, from Adam and the Ants to Jay Z.

MUZEUM SUSCH muzeumsusch.ch This Swiss institution – part-buried in the mountainside, with galleries elegantly converted from a Medieval monastery and a brewery – mines the

NEW MUSEUM newmuseum.org Are you sitting uncomfortably? Maurizio Cattelan has invited his friends to tell you a bedtime story; but with offerings such as David Byrne reading from psychiatric case-study *The Three Christs of Ypsilanti*, fairy tales are in short supply.

NMSU UNIVERSITY ART MUSEUM uam.nmsu.edu Necessity is the mother of invention in New Mexico, as a show about maternal identity and imagery in recent art gives birth to an online programme of performances and readings.

NOGUCHI MUSEUM noguchi.org The website expounds two projects by the Japanese/American polymath: a sky-high sculpture for Idlewild airport (a commission he eventually lost to Calder), and his mission to design the perfect ashtray.



ON FORM onformsculpture.co.uk Asthall Manor's biennial stone-sculpture show had an especially spectacular 20th-anniversary edition planned for 2020. An online showcase of its participants suggests what might have been.

OSBORNE SAMUEL osbornesamuel.com The indelible impression of war – even in peacetime – in rare prints by Nevinson and Nash.

OXFORD CERAMICS oxfordceramics.com Me old china: a centenary show of work by Hans Coper, his mentor Lucie Rie and their pupils.

PERFORMA performa-arts.org Action stations: how architects use performance in their work. Examples include Arata Isozaki's robot buildings and Aldo Rossi's floating theatre.

RIJKSMUSEUM rijksmuseum.nl The restoration of *The Night Watch* continues in a glass chamber in which two technicians may work at a time. You can see every dot of pigment from your own home, thanks to a new 44.8-gigapixel image stitched together from 528 exposures.

ROBERT YOUNG ANTIQUES robertyoungantiques.com Coo! A clutch of racing-pigeon portraits is a highlight of the Battersea dealer's annual folk-art show, this year in a digital format.

SAINSBURY CENTRE SCULPTURE PARK sainsburycentre.ac.uk Ramble through a 350-acre riverside park dotted with ancient oaks and sculptures by Chadwick, Frink and others.

SALISBURY MUSEUM salisburymuseum.org.uk A collaborative show asks members of the public to submit objects or pictures with a story to tell about this cathedral city, complementing museum treasures such as a 1770s snuff-seller's sign and a walrus-ivory chess piece.

TORNABUONI ART tornabuoniart.com, artland.com Real and virtual spaces for Italian art, with Morandi, Balla and De Chirico in the London gallery all summer, and online viewing rooms dedicated to Piero Dorazio, Renato Mambor, and Alighiero Boetti's works on paper.

VICTORIA MIRO x DAVID ZWIRNER sidebysideonline.com A group show from these regular collaborators, who share the representation of artists such as Alice Neel and Chris Ofili. It can also be viewed via the Vortic app, where the work appears in an extended-reality hybrid of the two Mayfair venues.

WALLACE COLLECTION wallacecollection.org Another look at the watercolours of glossy-leaved plants and bright-eyed birds commissioned by the East India Company (Wol Feb 2020). Curator William Dalrymple is your (virtual) guide ■
