STRETCHWEAR MEASURING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Measure firmly around and against the body; do not add or take inches away from the performer.
- 2. The performer should wear a leotard or tight-fitting garments (not baggy or loose street clothes) when being measured.
- 3. It is best for one or two people to do all of the measuring and recording for consistency purposes.
- 4. Measure according to FJM diagrams (next page).
 - Chest (Measure firmly around the fullest part of the chest)
 - Waist (Measure firmly around the belly button/natural waistline)
 - Hips (Measure firmly around the fullest part of the hips)
 - Girth (Measure from the center front neckline, between legs -pull tightly- up to cervical bone at center back neckline. Do not measure shoulder to shoulder.)
 - Arm (Measure top of shoulder to wrist)
 - Inseam (Measure from the crotch down to ankle bone)
 - Height
 - Weight
- 5. Please indicate and separate male and female performers on your measuring charts. Do not submit measuring charts with male and female measurements intermixed.
- 6. Always send completed measuring charts with your order.
- 7. All alterations are the responsibility of the customer. FJM typically sizes stretchwear orders in size ranges Adult Extra Small through Adult 7XL. We also have length ranges of short, standard, and long to accommodate varying heights and inseams. Garment sizes are assigned according to the measurement information received. FJM does not guarantee a perfect custom fit as all body types are different. Minor alterations and custom tailoring may be required.
- 8. All FJM uniforms are custom made especially for your program. Therefore, once your order has been placed on the production schedule, cancellation is not allowed. Please contact your customer service representative with questions.
- 9. All FJM uniforms are custom made and manufactured to your specifications. Therefore, uniform orders are not returnable or exchangeable. Check your order immediately upon receipt and notify customer service at 800-444-3524 within 5 business days if any defects or discrepancies are found.

All measurements begin at the dot and proceed through to the tip of the arrow.

*Chest, waist, and hip measurements are to be made completely around the body, keeping the tape measure parallel with the ground.
