SESSION 1: I'm a Priest!

- 1. What two elements were Adam and Eve made out of? Why are these two elements important?
- 2. What do you think would happen if every person in our congregations realized that they are walking meeting places between heaven and earth?
- 3. Read Deuteronomy 10:8. What are the three duties of a priest?
- 4. Read 2 Corinthians 4:7. What does it mean that we are "vessels of glory"?
- 5. What is the Holy Spirit speaking to you through this session?

SESSION 2: What is Worship?

- 1. Before learning about the Hebrew and Greek words for worship, how would you have defined worship?
- 2. What do you think would happen if you began your day worshipping as much as demons do? What would happen if every Christian began their day this way?
- 3. What happens if you have love without lordship? What if you have lordship without love?
- 4. Read Romans 5:8. How did God express the posture of His heart to us? How do we express the posture of our hearts to God?
- 5. Explain this statement: "Music is a tool to worship, but music itself isn't worship."
- 6. How does worship create more worship?
- 7. What is the Holy Spirit speaking to you through this session?

SESSION 3: What is Praise?

- 1. Why can't you praise God without expressing it?
- 2. What are some of the benefits of praise?
- 3. Read Exodus 17:8-13. Explain this statement: "Physical expression has spiritual consequences."
- 4. Why is it important to submit your denominational culture to God's Kingdom culture?
- 5. "Praise is an invitation for God to fight." In what ways is this important in your life?
- 6. What is the significance of Jesus being the Lion of the tribe of Judah?
- 7. What is the Holy Spirit speaking to you through this session?

SESSION 4: God's Family, God's House

- 1. What are the three elements of the Tabernacle discussed in this session? What do they reflect about worship?
- 2. Have you ever tried to read the Bible with an unsubmitted heart? What happened?
- 3. Why is it so important that the songs we sing in church be Scripturally true?
- 4. Read John 10:9. What is significant about the gate to the Tabernacle?
- 5. Remembrance is part of worship. How can remembering the cross affect your prayer life and submission?
- 6. What is the Holy Spirit speaking to you through this session?

SESSION 5: Intimacy with God

- 1. What did the bread and wine in the Holy Place prophetically symbolize?
- 2. What does intimacy with God mean to you? What does it look or sound like?
- 3. Explain this statement: "We weren't just saved from something. We were also saved to something."
- 4. Why should the fruit of the Spirit and the gifts of the Spirit always coincide with each other?
- 5. What is the Holy Spirit speaking to you through this session?

SESSION 6: The Throne of God

- 1. What is the conflict that priests faced when entering the Most Holy Place?
- 2. How can we as priests put the altar of incense into practice in our personal worship?
- 3. Read Ephesians 3:20. What would you like to see God do in your life and in your church?
- 4. If the Tabernacle is an earthly shadow of heavenly worship, how do you think we are doing (as Christians/the Church) representing heavenly worship to the world? What are we getting right? What needs to change?
- 5. What is the Holy Spirit speaking to you through this session?

SESSION 7 (BONUS): Worship Leaders

- 1. How is worship a gift from God to God?
- 2. Why did the people of Israel shout and fall down when fire came from the Lord's presence?
- 3. Why did Nadab and Abihu die in the Lord's presence? How should this serve as a warning to us today?
- 4. Explain this statement: "Minister to the One, and you minister to everyone."
- 5. How does worship connect heaven and earth?
- 6. What is the Holy Spirit speaking to you through this session?

SESSION 8 (BONUS): Pastors

- 1. Why do you think some churches have a "presence problem"?
- 2. What are some ways you can keep your church from just being a sanctified book club?
- 3. What is your first calling?
- 4. How do you think the local church would change if leaders used their authority to elevate God instead of themselves?
- 5. Why is it important for the pastor to be the most expressive worshipper in the room?
- 6. What is the Holy Spirit speaking to you through this session?
