Kindy/Prep

Chrissie Mobiles (mixed media) – using a wide range of 2D and 3D media, students will create a fun hanging sculpture. Students will learn about weaving/ sculpture/ collage/ assemblage.

Fun Clay Christmas Tile (clay) – using clay, and assorted decorative media, students will create their own Christmas inspired ceramic tile. A great tactile lesson.

Christmas Stenciling (mixed media) – Students will create a Christmas motif stencil, and will learn how to make simple prints with them onto coloured paper. They will then be mounted into one awesome vibrant artwork. Ho Ho Ho!

Printing Christmas Cards (printmaking) – students will create their own Christmas designs, etch them into Print Foam, and then learn how to print their designs. Students will create a set of creative cards, using their prints and some cool collage media. Fun!

Year 1 / 2 - Stage 1

Christmas Tree Weavings (mixed media) – students will work with a range of 3D media to create awesome Christmas Tree weavings. Children will love the tactile process, and the end results will look truly festive hanging around your classroom.

Christmas Mix Media Mobiles (printmaking/mix media) – Students will enjoy making these cool mobiles. They will create large collaged and printed Christmas shapes, and will then assemble into a fantastic mobile.

Little Clay Reindeers (clay/sculpture) – children will love their little clay reindeers. Using clay, and some assorted decorative media, students will be taken through a fun step by step process of modeling clay. Great fun!

Cool Chrissie tags (printmaking) – a fun creative lesson – children etch a simple Christmas motif into Print foam, and will then learn how to print their designs. Prints will then be used to create a series of festive Chrissie tags.



Year 3 / 4 – Stage 2

Christmas Clay Pots (ceramics) – students will learn all about clay, and simple ceramic processes. They will work toward creating a cool ceramic pot, decorated in Christmas motifs. Ho Ho Ho!

Christmas Screen print Designs (printmaking) – discover the joy of screen-printing! Children will love creating their stencils, and learning the basics of screen-printing. Prints will be mounted into an awesome Christmas Design.

Creative Christmas Chemograms (photo media) – students will work with basic Photo Media equipment (fixer/developer/photo paper), and will learn some simple cool effects using photo chemicals. These designs will be used to create a set of vibrant Christmas cards. Fun!

Groovy Christmas Wall hanging (printmaking/ mix media) – a fun activity based on printmaking/collage/ assemblage. Students will use a wide range of media, and will create some fun hanging art works, ready for Christmas display!

Year 5 / 6 – Stage 3

Decorative Chrissie Clay Tile (ceramics) – students will love creating these ceramic Christmas tiles. Students will learn some cool clay modeling techniques, and will learn about the properties of clay.

Print Foam Chrissie Cards (printmaking/ mix media) – students will learn about relief printing, by etching their designs into their foam tiles, and will then be taken through the process of printing and mounting. Students will create a series of hand printed Christmas cards – awesome!

Op Art Christmas mobile (sculpture) – this is a great sculpture lesson, using card/ paper and some other assorted decorative media. Results are fantastic, and will transform your classroom.

Funky Wrapping Paper (printmaking) – students will create a few different types of stampers using clay and cardboard. They will discover the principals of printmaking, and will work at creating their own unique wrapping paper design.
