Junior (Ages 5 - 8)

Cool Block Prints

Printmaking

Students will be introduced to the basics of Printmaking – learning the processes and skills of making and printing a printblock. Students will be looking at shape, line, colour and patterns. The finished mounted artwork will be colourful and vibrant.

Wonderful Weaving

textiles/ Sculpture

Using a wide range of different 2D and 3D media, students will use their imagination to create a fantastic weaving. Students will discover shape, colour, pattern, texture and balance. An awesome introduction to weaving and sculpture!

Arty Aussie Animals

Mixed Media

using a variety of 2D media including paints, pastels and charcoal, students will be creating an awesome Aboriginal-inspired masterpiece. We will be looking at lizards, turtles and fish, and will be using colours from nature. Students will love the process and will be proud of their fantastic finished designs.

Bobble Head Birds

Clay

An awesome clay activity with students learning about 3D sculpture and the properties of clay. Students will love making these quirky fun little birds, with their little moving bobble heads. Learn about the properties of clay and also 3D sculpture, while having fun with wire, beads, and pipecleaners.

Senior (Ages 9 - 12)

Creative Chemograms

Photography

Using an exciting series of chemical processes students will explore a different way of creating pattern and texture in an artwork. Using photographic paper and chemicals students will focus on positive and negative space, contrast, and texture.

Clay Dragon Heads or Medieval Clay tiles

Clay sculpture

Both are excellent clay sculpture activities, with great imaginative results. Students are taken through a step by step lesson in constructing their very own Dragon Head sculptures – or a Medieval inspired Ceramic tile design.

Mixed Media Mexican Skulls

Mixed Media

Students use paints, pastels, collage media, while learning about Mexican culture. Mexicans have long celebrated the 'Day of the Dead', celebrating their Ancestral History with the adornment of decorative skulls. Students will be drawing on inspiration from these creative vibrant skull designs to create their own Mexican wall hanging.

Zig Zag Zines

- Mixed Media

Zines' are the latest in self published magazines and comics. Students will get to create their own personal zine, using a range of different 2D media. Students will be guided towards creating a 6-page zine, full of creativity, imagination and fun – using images/text/ drawing/stamping/ collage/stenciling.

All Ages

Mural Art

Painting/Drawing

Set your own theme for this fun group based activity. Using a range of 2D media including pastels and paint, students will work collaboratively to create a stunning large scale artwork. Some possible themes – monsters, insects, Picasso, faces, under the sea, Jungle, Fairytales...

Beautiful Bugs

Painting/Drawing

the miniature creatures of the insect world never fail to fascinate, and these beautiful illustrations will do the same. Students will exercise their drawing skills, being taught how to use simple shape to build an image of an insect. This workshop also introduces students to basic watercolour painting techniques.

Clay Masks

A great clay activity for all ages. Students are taken through a step by step lesson, with children creating their own unique mask art piece.

Simple Screenprinting –
