



Care Instructions

Please read these instructions before use of this product.
Keep this instruction sheet as it contains important information.



- Wash before use (Boiling is not necessary).
- **DO NOT** use this product for purposes that are not originally intended.
- **DO NOT** use over direct heat.
- **DO NOT** use this product once it's damaged.
- Handle broken pieces carefully.
- **DO NOT** drag on surfaces that can be easily scratched.

- Wash promptly after each use.
- Wash with a soft sponge and a neutral kitchen detergent, rinse, and dry well before storing.
- **DO NOT** use a scouring cleanser or a stainless steel scrubber.
- For tough stains, like tea incrustation, use a kitchen bleach properly.

- It may get gray marks from rubbing against metalware. Hand wash these marks with a soft sponge and a cleanser as they will not come off with a neutral kitchen detergent. However, tough gray marks may not come off completely.

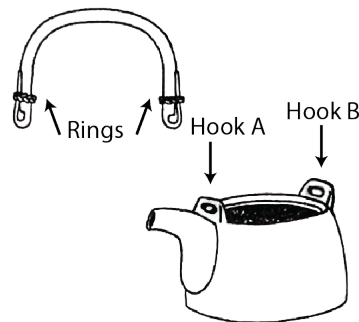
- Please note that the unglazed, textured part of this product is more susceptible to stains.

Care Instructions for the Handle of Hot Pot

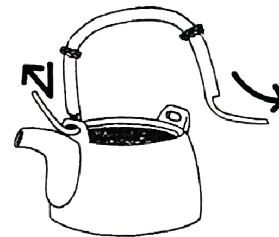
- The handle is made from Polyvinyl chloride (PVC).
- Color and wood grain may vary.
- It could break if bent and stretched repeatedly or strongly bent.
- The thin part could break or crack if a force is applied suddenly.
- **DO NOT** use the handle once it's damaged.
- **DO NOT** presoak.
- **DO NOT** soak in hot water or use near fire.
- **DO NOT** use in dishwasher, microwave, or oven.
- Hand wash without removing the handle.
- The rings for the handle are made from wicker.
- **DO NOT** presoak for an extended period of time, store without drying, or store in a humid space.

- How to put the handle

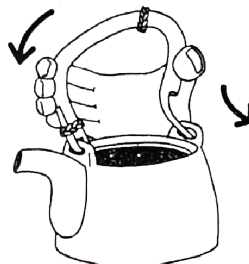
① Remove the lid.



② Pull up the rings and insert "Hook A." Gently open up "Hook B."



③ Tilt the handle towards the spout, bend the handle inward slowly, and insert "Hook B."



④ Pull down the rings and make sure the handle is locked before use.
