



## Care Instructions for Tea Utensils

Please read these instructions before use of these products.

Keep this instruction sheet as it contains important information.



- Clean immediately after each use to avoid molding.
- **DO NOT** use dish detergent.
- Dry well before storing.

### Whisk (Chasen)



- Whisk is used to mix matcha and hot water.
- In addition to regular size whisks, there is a smaller whisk to use outdoors (Nodate).
- Put it on the whisk keeper to pull into shape.
- Wash promptly with lukewarm water after each use.
- **DO NOT** leave this product in a dry area or direct sunlight.

### Whisk Keeper (Chasenyasume)



- Whisk Keeper is used to maintain the shape of Whisk.

### Tea Scoop (Chashaku)



- Tea Scoop is used to scoop matcha from a container to a matcha bowl.
- Wipe with a dry soft paper or cloth like facial tissue if matcha adheres to the product (Use fukusa if available).
- **DO NOT** rub strongly.
- Dry off the Chawan well before using this product.
- **DO NOT** wash with water.
- **DO NOT** leave this product in a dry area or direct sunlight.

### Saucer (Chataku)



- Saucer is used to place a tea bowl to serve tea.
- Wipe with a dry or well-wrung cloth.
- **DO NOT** leave this product dirty or wet.
- **DO NOT** wash with water.

### Matcha Canister (Natsume)



- Matcha Canister is used to store matcha.
- Put the content in another container and wipe with facial tissue.

### Matcha Bowl (Chawan)



- Matcha Bowl is used to serve matcha.
- Wash with hands without using a sponge with lukewarm water.
- Rub well with fingers to remove matcha.
- To store for an extended period of time, dry in a well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight.
- Keep the right side up while drying the product.

### Ladle (Hishaku) for Furo



- Ladle for Furo is used to serve hot water from Furo to a matcha bowl.
- Length of the handle is 13.58 in, and diameter of the deep part of the bowl is 2.24 in.
- **DO NOT** leave this product dirty or wet.



- Furo is a furnace to heat the Chagama to prepare hot water. Furo is used during summer.

### Ladle (Hishaku) for Ro



- Ladle for Ro is used to serve hot water from Ro to a matcha bowl.
- Length of the handle is 13.58 in, and diameter of the deep part of the bowl is 2.36 in.
- **DO NOT** leave this product dirty or wet.



- Ro is a built-in furnace installed on a floor of a tea room to heat the Chagama to prepare hot water. Ro is used during winter.
