
UNIVERSAL FRONT OR REAR MUD GUARDS FOR MEDIUM SIZE VEHICLES

Tools Needed

- Drill with 1/8" Bit
- · Center punch
- · Phillips head screwdriver

Included in Box

- Universal Mud Guards (for driver & passenger side)
- #10 Screws and Washers (x8)
- U-Clips (x8)
- Plastic Fasteners (x2)



Repeat Steps 1-3 for Driver & Passenger Side

OPTION 1. Use existing screws.

- a. Locate existing factory screws that can be used to mount the mud guards, and remove.
- b. Mark factory screws location on mud guard and drill 1/4" hole into the mud guard.
- c. Attach mud guard to fenders using factory screws.

OPTION 2. Use existing holes in fender.

- a. Mark factory hole locations on mud guard and drill 1/4" hole into mud guard.
- b. Using a #10 Screws and Washers, secure the mud guard with a U-Clip located over or behind the fender hole.
- c. Included fasteners can be used instead of the #10 Screws and Washers and U-Clip if existing hole is correct size.

OPTION 3. Drilling hole locations.

- a. Find mounting location on vehicle. Mark and drill 1/8" hole near the top of the mud guard.
- b. Attach mud guard at and new locations with #10 Screws and Washers.
- c. Use the mud guard as a template, center punch and drill evenly spaced 1/8" holes at any remaining locations. (A, B, or C)
- d. Using #10 Screws and Washers secure mud guard at newly drilled hole locations. (A, B, or C)
