• Drill with 1/8" bit · Rear Mud Guards (for driver & passenger side) Center punch · Film to protect vehicle · Phillips head screwdriver • #10 Screws and Washers (x2) • U-Clips (x2) 2 C. FILM TO PROTECT VEHICLE 3 D. Ð Fender Line #10 Screw U-Clip Ð Mud Guard В. Figure 1 (Location D)

STEP 1. Remove existing fasteners.

Tools Needed

a. Remove your existing fasteners from locations A, B and C.

STEP 2. Apply film to protect vehicle.

a. Using a clean cloth or wet alcohol pad, clean the area on the fender where the film (to protect vehicle) will be placed.

Repeat Steps 1-3 for Driver & Passenger Side

b. Use soapy water to wet film, fender, and fingers for a wet film installation. Apply film in location shown in diagram, with adhesive side of film towards the vehicle. Apply pressure and smooth out film with a squeegee or sponge and allow to dry.

STEP 3. Install mud guards.

- a. Using your existing factory fasteners, attach the mud guard at locations A, B and C.
- b. Drill 1/8" holes at location D using the mud guard as a guide.
- c. Install a #10 Screw and Washer at location D into a U-Clip. Use the U-Clip as a nut behind the fender liner. (Figure 1)
