

Tape-in Tips and Tricks

For your clients

Washing

- Wait at least 48 hours after install before washing hair.
- Only use recommend shampoo and conditioner.
- Avoid using conditioner on the tape tabs.

Brushing

- Use a recommended brush.
- Hold tape tabs securely to the head.
- Start brushing at the bottom, and work up the hair.

Sleeping

- Sleep with a loose plait to minimize strain on extensions through the night.

For you

Achieve the longest hold times possible for your client with the following instructions.

Prewash

- Make sure your clients hair is washed with clarifying shampoo and the roots are free from conditioner or other hair products before install.

Heat

- Can apply one second of heat to the tape during installation with a flat iron for a longer, more secure hold. The heat activates the tape to better adhere to the hair.

Avoid touching

- Avoid touching the tape's adhesive because it risks decreasing hold times. Since it's hard to avoid completely, wash your hands of any lotions or oils.

Removing

- Use Tape bond remover to remove extensions from the hair and tape from the weft.

Clean Extensions

- Prepare extensions for re-installs by removing all residue off the weft's tape strip.

Failure

- Each client has unique hair, some oiler and some drier.
- Tape tabs should be used within 3 months of purchasing
- Must be kept in a sealed packet and out of direct sunlight.
- The climate can greatly affect the tapes.
