Please carefully read and adhere to the following requirements before contacting the art curator:

- Do you have enough work for editing purposes?
- There are two exhibiting areas to fill.
- A minimum of 6-8 large pieces or the equivalent in small or medium-sized pieces.
- Is your work cohesive?
- Theme, color, medium, subject matter, types of framing - at least two of these elements must be the same.
- Do you have an Artist Statement and/or Biography (and business cards?)
- Why am I doing what I am doing?
- What is my background?

Violence and/or explicit sexual depictions will not be considered. Batdorf & Bronson's policy also discourages obvious religious or political depictions.

1. A brief description of your work.
2. The dimensions of each piece.
3. Your preparation for hanging (art rail hooks are provided- no nails or hanging apparatus can be attached to walls.)

If chosen, title and price labels will be needed for each piece.
