Ravine Home Care Instructions

Our Ravine Home products are made for real life and designed with high-quality materials and construction methods to meet the demands of a busy life. With regular care, your Ravine Home purchase should maintain its looks year after year.

General Care

- Vacuum upholstery weekly to remove loose particles as dirt and dust can cause fabric to wear faster.
- Rotate, flip and fluff removable cushions and pillows weekly to distribute wear.
- Feather and down cushion regain their loft easily but should be fluffed frequently. Some feather loss and migration is normal. Vacuuming between the feather casing and the cushion cover will help prevent feathers from poking through.
- Attached cushions will stretch and wrinkle with use. Smoothing the surface and tucking any excess upholstery into the seat sides or back can easily restore the look of your tight cushion.
- All fabric and leather will fade over time. Avoid placing your piece in direct sunlight to minimize the fading over time.
- Although rare, pilling can occur due to normal friction and does not indicate excessive wear. To remove it, you can eliminate the excess fibers on the surface of the fabric with a pill shaver or de-fuzzer tool.

Cleaning Guidelines

- Treat stains immediately for the best results. Blot up as much of the spill as possible with a clean, dry, white cloth. Don't rub.
- Do not dry clean or machine wash cushion covers as doing so may cause damage.
- Check the standard cleaning code (below) to determine the correct type of product to use prior to treatment of a stain.

- Apply a small amount of cleaner to the stain and gently agitate it with your fingertips. Avoid oversaturation.
- Continue to apply cleaner sparingly and blot until the stain no longer transfers onto the cloth. This may take several attempts.
- Dry spot with a hair dryer on the lowest heat setting to evenly dry the fabric and prevent moisture rings.
- Always pretest cleaning agents in a small inconspicuous area.
- Pile fabrics may require brushing with a nonmetallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance.
- For large or persistent stains, contact an in-home professional upholstery cleaning company.
- Annual professional cleaning will keep your sofa looking its best.

Fabric Cleaning Codes

Standard Cleaning Codes indicate the correct cleaning method based on the type of fabric on your Ravine Home Piece.

W: Water-Spot clean using distilled water and water-based cleaning agents or foam only.

S: Solvent-Spot clean with mild, water-free cleaning solvents only. Do not use water or dry clean.

SW: Solvent or Water-Spot clean using distilled water and water-based cleaning agents, foam or mild water-free cleaning solvents.

X: Vacuum or lightly brush to remove overall soil. Never use water, foam or liquid cleaning agents.
