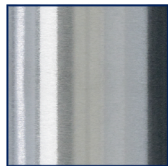


FLAGPOLES (ALUMINUM)

Things To Consider...

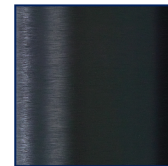
- Aluminum is louder than fiberglass; snaps make more noise, even with covers.

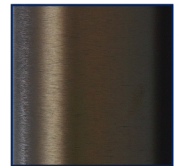

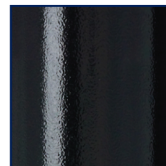
