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Mater x Eva Harlou introducing a new and distinctive glass carafe: Double Bottle

Double Bottle is designed by the Danish architect Eva Harlou. The carafe is crafted in hand-blown borosilicate glass. This original, yet functional piece of design features a two-room carafe with cork/oak plugs.

"The design is based on a desire to create some functional in connection with table coverings. Double Bottle is a design that appeals to both father, mother and friends; for both children and adults, and I think it's great that you can gather around a design like that," says architect Eva Harlou.

The small carafe is implemented in the large, and rests elegantly on a foot of FSC certified oak. The outermost carafe is additionally the handle of Double Bottle, which gives a perfect grip. Fill with sparkling/still water, gin/tonic, blackcurrant/water, aperol/prosecco, water/red wine or your favourite combination of drinks for a stylish and easy way to serve.

Borosilicate glass, originally used for laboratory glassware, is known for its high level of resistance to thermal shock, making the Double Bottle suitable for both hot and cold liquids.

About the Designer

Eva Harlou is a Danish architect graduated from Aarhus School of Architecture in 2003. Harlou's designs illustrate her Scandinavian sense of form, function and beauty while at the same time working internationally ambitiously and always creating something unique. Harlou has been awarded with "Best Breakthrough Designer" by Wallpaper * Magazine in 2007, and has her own architectural firm in Copenhagen from where she designs both buildings and furniture.
