


Assembly Steps

Before the assembly, please check to make sure that you have all parts listed on the Parts List.


Step 1 Layout and form the top frame with the poles (6 x #1, 6 x #2, and 6 x #4) and the connectors (6 x #A & 3 x #B).

Reminder

There is a built-in snap at one end of the poles (#1, #2, and #4). Please snap to fix them together.





Step 2 Fix the Roof Cover (#C) to the assembled top frame with the help of some Bungee Cords (#I).




Step 3 Start assembling the mainframe.

- a) Add 3 x poles (#3) to the connectors (#A & #B) on one side, then lift the structure from the other side (several adults required!).
- b) On the other side, add the rest 3 x poles (#3) to the connectors (#A & #B).






- Step 4 Secure the structure with the L-Shaped Pegs (#D), Auger Anchors (#E), Foot Bases (#F), Screws (#G), and Ropes (#H).
 - a) Add a Foot Base (#F) to the bottom of each pole (#3), then fix with a Screw (#G). Repeat what you've done with the other 5 foot bases and poles (#3).
 - b) Insert the 6 x L-Shaped Peg (#D) into the hole of 6 x Foot Bases (#F), one for each.
 - c) Fix the whole structure to the ground with 6 x Ropes (#H) and 6 x Auger Anchors (#E). We highly recommend you diagonally insert the anchors when fixing the ropes to the ground. As shown, a 45-degree angle would be the best.




Assembly Steps

- Before the assembly, please check to make sure that you have all parts listed on the Parts List.
- For your safety, please always wear gloves (#N) before and during the assembly.

Step 1 Form the top frame as per the following steps.


- a) Layout the frame with the poles $(6 \times #1, 6 \times #2, \text{ and } 6 \times #4)$ and the connectors $(4 \times #A, 2 \times #B, 2 \times \#C, \text{ and } 1 \times \#D)$.
- b) Put the two ends of each Steel Cable (#E) onto the ends of connectors (#A & #B) as shown.
- c) Fix all the poles and connectors together by snapping the built-in pins.






Step 2 Adjust the 3 x Steel Cables (#E).

- a) Hook the cables to the connectors (#C & #D) at the top.
- b) Tighten/loosen the cables to a proper height with the help of the height controller.




Step 3 Start assembling the mainframe.

- a) Fix the Roof Cover (#G) to the assembled top frame with the help of some Bungee Cords (#L).
- b) Add 3 x poles (#3) to the connectors (#A & #B) on one side, then lift the structure from the other side (several adults required!).
- c) On the other side, add the rest 3 x poles (#3) to the connectors (#A & #B).



Step 4 Secure the whole structure.

- a) Connect each pole (#3) at the bottom with a Foot Base (#F) by using a Screw (#J).
- b) Insert an L-Shaped Peg (#H) into the hole of each Foot Base (#F).
- c) Secure the whole structure with 6 x Ropes (#K) and 6 x Auger Anchors (#I). We highly recommend you diagonally insert the pegs when fixing the ropes to the ground. As shown, a 45-degree angle would be the best.
- d) Weigh the structure down with 4 x Sandbags (#M) at the four corners.






Assembly Steps

Before the assembly, please check to make sure that you have all parts listed on the **Parts List.**

Step 1 Form the top frame as per the following steps.


- a) Layout the frame with the poles (9 x #1 & 8 x #2) and the connectors (4 x #A, 4 x #B, 2 x #C, and 2 x #D).
- b) Put the two ends of each Steel Cable (#L) onto the ends of connectors (#A & #B) as shown.
- c) Fix all the poles and connectors together by snapping the built-in pins.






Step 2 Adjust the 4 x Steel Cables (#L).


- a) Hook them to the connectors (#C & #D) at the top.
- b) Tighten/loosen the cables to a proper height with the help of the height controller.



Step 3 Start assembling the mainframe.


- a) Fix the Roof Cover (#E) to the assembled top frame with the help of some Bungee Cords (#K).
- b) Add 4 x poles (#3) to the connectors (#A & #B) on one side, then lift the structure from the other side (several adults required!).
- c) On the other side, add the rest 4 x poles (#3) to the connectors (#A & #B).





Step 4 Secure the whole structure.

- a) Connect each pole (#3) at the bottom with a Foot Base (#F) by using a Screw (#I).
- b) Insert an L-Shaped Peg (#G) into the hole of each Foot Base (#F).
- c) Secure the whole structure with 8 x Ropes (#J) and 8 x Auger Anchors (#H). We highly recommend you diagonally insert the pegs when fixing the ropes to the ground. As shown, a 45-degree angle would be the best.



Maintenance

To help you maintain your carport in optimal condition, please refer to our suggestions below.

- When in use, make sure to brush off dirt and debris and keep away from potentially damaging objects.
- Clean the cover and sidewalls with water and mild detergent (or non-detergent, if applicable) only.
- To prevent your carport from rust and mildew, please clean all disassembled parts and dry them completely before storing them.
- Store the disassembled carport in a cool and dry place and keep away from animals.
- Inspect your tent carefully before and after each use. If any rips, tears, or damage is found, stop
 using it and email the support team (sales@quictents.com or maxlead.us@gmail.com) with
 the ORDER NUMBER, PART NUMBER, QUANTITY REQUIRED, and ANY PHOTOS (OR VIDEO
 CLIPS, IF APPLICABLE), we will get back to you in 12 hours.

Warranty

The limited warranty covering the materials and the craftsmanship under normal use and service conditions takes effect from the purchase date (on the invoice). Please note that the order purchase proof (order number or shipping information on the shipping carton) is the only valid evidence to claim for warranty.

- 12-month warranty for the Steel Pole, Cover, and Zipper Door.
- A lifetime warranty for all the small accessories not mentioned above, including the Connectors, Pegs, Auger Anchors, Foot Bases, etc.

Reminders


