

A Five-Minute Guide to Getting Proof of Vaccination on Your Phone



STEP ONE

Log in to your Mygov account (on your phone, that part's important)

Find your Mygov login details, and log yourself into the website on your phone. (Make sure it's your phone, otherwise, well, you won't be able to add it to your phone.)



STEP TWO

Find your Medicare card (or equivalent)

I'm on my family's Medicare card, so be prepared to call a parent for the info you need. If you have your own card, get it out and ready. It's also fine if you don't have Medicare or aren't eligible for it. Use Mygov to link to an Individual Healthcare Identifiers (IHI) service instead. (Read how to get an IHI at the link in bio.)



STEP THREE

Link your Medicare to your Mygov

If you've already done this before, congrats, you're a better adult than me and can skip this step. But if you haven't, it's really easy. There's a "quick links" section on the Mygov homepage linking to Medicare. Follow the steps, input the information it asks for, and you'll be set up within minutes.



STEP FOUR

Click on "proof of Covid-19 vaccination" then add it to your phone

Back on the Mygov homepage, click on the "proof of Covid-19 vaccination" link in the quick-links section. Once you click through, you'll be able to view either your full immunisation history or you can click "view Covid-19 digital certificate" (as a PDF). Under this, you'll have the option to add it to your Apple Wallet if you use an iPhone, or to Google Pay if you're with Android. Click that and you're good to go. If this isn't available - don't worry. It can take up to 10 days after your second jab before your immunisation status goes through.

BONUS STEPS

Add your Covid-19 digital certificate to the Service Victoria app. Here's how:

Add your certificate using either the Express Plus Medicare app, or your online Medicare account.



BONUS STEPS

If you're using your Medicare account via Mygov

- Sign into Mygov on a browser on your device
- Scroll to "proof of Covid-19 vaccination" and hit "go to Medicare"
- Select "share with check-in app"
- Select "Service Victoria" and follow the prompts
- Review the terms and conditions and hit "accept and share" if everything is in check
- Once you see your digital certificate pop up, hit "add certificate"



BONUS STEPS

If you're using the Express Plus Medicare app

- In the app, select "proof of vaccinations"
- Hit "view history"
- If you share your Medicare account, select your name. Otherwise, it should be auto-selected.
- Select "share with check-in app"
- Read the terms and conditions, then hit "accept and share"
- Tap "add certificate"
