The Covid 19 pandemic has required us to make major changes to our day-to-day behaviours. But is this any reason to sacrifice our ecological concerns by using millions of paper masks which have a huge impact on the environment? Why endanger our own health and that of others by using fabric face coverings which may or may not be effective? Swiss company KT Home SA, a specialist in microfibres, has developed an antimicrobial mask for general use which is ergonomic, ultralight, washable and reusable. Made in Switzerland and available in six sizes, the Everyday 2.0 mask is one of only two "community masks" to have been certified by Testex® in compliance with the requirements of the "Swiss National COVID-19 Science Task Force". Combining optimal protection, ecology and savings

chemical products, with the added bonus of an exclusive innovation developed in our Biel / Bienne factory, for which we have filed a patent application.

Result: an ultralight, ergonomic, anti-UV mask, which makes it possible to breathe comfortably, keeps its shape and prevents glasses from fogging up if it is properly fitted. An anti-allergen mask which is ideally suited to sensitive skin and can be worn for several hours at a time. A re-usable mask that can be machine washed at 60° and retains all its antimicrobial efficacy until it is totally worn out (until a hole appears).



A TESTEX®-CERTIFIED COMMUNITY MASK

The "community mask" is an antimicrobial mask intended for general wear in any situation where it is compulsory or advisable to protect each other, except for medical staff working in a hospital environment.

La "Swiss National COVID-19 Science Task Force" has established detailed criteria for community masks, which can be applied to two very demanding certifications:

Oeko-Tex 100

This certification guarantees a neutral product, without the addition of any chemical substances that are harmful to health, where all aspects are very carefully controlled: quality of fibres, dyes and seam threads (for cotton the fibres must not contain any pesticides).

Testex[®],

These tests are carried out by the EMPA (Federal laboratory for testing materials and research) and guarantee optimal performance at all levels:

- Particle filtration efficacy: the mask must filter at least 70% of aerosols with an average size of 1.0 micrometre
- 2. Air permeability less than 70 pascal per cm²
- Splash resistant: no penetration of liquids in accordance with European standards EN1468
- **4.** Solidity and resistant to washing (resistant to changes in colour and size, resistant to saliva and perspiration).

The Everyday 2.0 mask fulfils all of the conditions required by these two certifications, and exceeds the Task Force requirements for particle filtration.

It is one of only two community masks to currently benefit from the Testex® label, which makes our business a public interest company.

INCREASED EFFICACY

Compared with our Everyday Classic mask, which offers excellent protection, the Everyday 2.0 mask provides even greater efficacy for only a small difference in price.

To compare the fibres in the two masks we asked the Swiss Integrative Center for Human Health (SICHH) laboratory in Fribourg to carry out microscope imaging. This imaging was performed on stretched masks to replicate how the fabric is stretched when worn. Two major differences can be observed:


- 1. The fibre of the Everyday 2.0 mask became finer, it has almost double the number of microfilaments over an equal surface area in comparison with the Everyday Classic. The denser the fibres, the more effective the filtration.
- 2.There are about three times fewer pores over an equal surface area in the Everyday 2.0 mask fibre that in that of the Everyday Classic mask. This characteristic confirms the higher filtration performance of the Everyday 2.0 model.













A SENSIBLE ALTERNATIVE TO PAPER MASKS



The problems associated with paper or cellulose masks go beyond deforestation, which is in itself an ecological disaster. Used masks can be seen everywhere, on pavements, on verges, in lakes and oceans around the globe - with serious repercussions not only for human beings, but also for our planet's flora and fauna. In addition, various studies into the subject clearly demonstrate that millions of masks are not compliant with protection requirements.

Paper and cellulose masks have many disadvantages in terms of health, ecology and finances:

- They present a health risk due to lack of certification and the use of toxic materials
- They endanger the health of the general public, as they are still liable to be infected

- They have a significant impact on the planet, because they are so light that they can fall out of pockets or are simply thrown down on ground.
- They generate considerable volumes of waste, because they must be disposed of after 3 to 8 hours of use or when they are wet.
- They are expensive to import, with exponential volumes occupying significant space (air transport)
- Their disposal creates problems as they release toxic gases into the environment.

In comparison, Everyday 2.0 stands out with its certified filtration performance, its innocuousness and its ability to be washed and reused.

Thanks to its microfibre composition, it doesn't need to be washed after each use. Simply hang it up in an isolated space for a minimum of 12 hours - this is why it is recommended that you wear 2 masks alternately. Once it is worn out, the mask should be washed a last time and then placed in a textiles recycling bag.

Since the middle of December 2019, China has opened more than 38,000 paper mask factories.

In addition to their protective properties and light weight, we spent a lot of time on the design of our masks to guarantee optimal comfort, meaning it can be worn for several hours at a time. Their shape was designed to provide sufficient cover without letting anything pass, to stay perfectly in place without needing to be readjusted by hand and to be comfortable around the ears. Deliberately understated, this ergonomic design means that masks can be worn in all circumstances.

SIX SIZES FOR ALL AGES AND FACES

To ensure that the masks fit everybody's morphology perfectly, we have developed and now offer six sizes, one of which is intended for children aged 8 (-/+2 years).

UNE LARGE PALETTE DE COULEURS

Aesthetic appearance has also been improved with a selection of colours to suit every taste.

Our masks are currently available in the following colours:

- black with blue and blue thread for the Everyday 2.0 mask
- black, blue, khaki, white with red, burgundy and black interior with blue thread for the Everyday Classic mask.

We are also waiting for the 2.0 certification for the black, blue and khaki models.

As the seasons change, new colours will be added to this range in order to suit various wardrobes, both male and female.
