

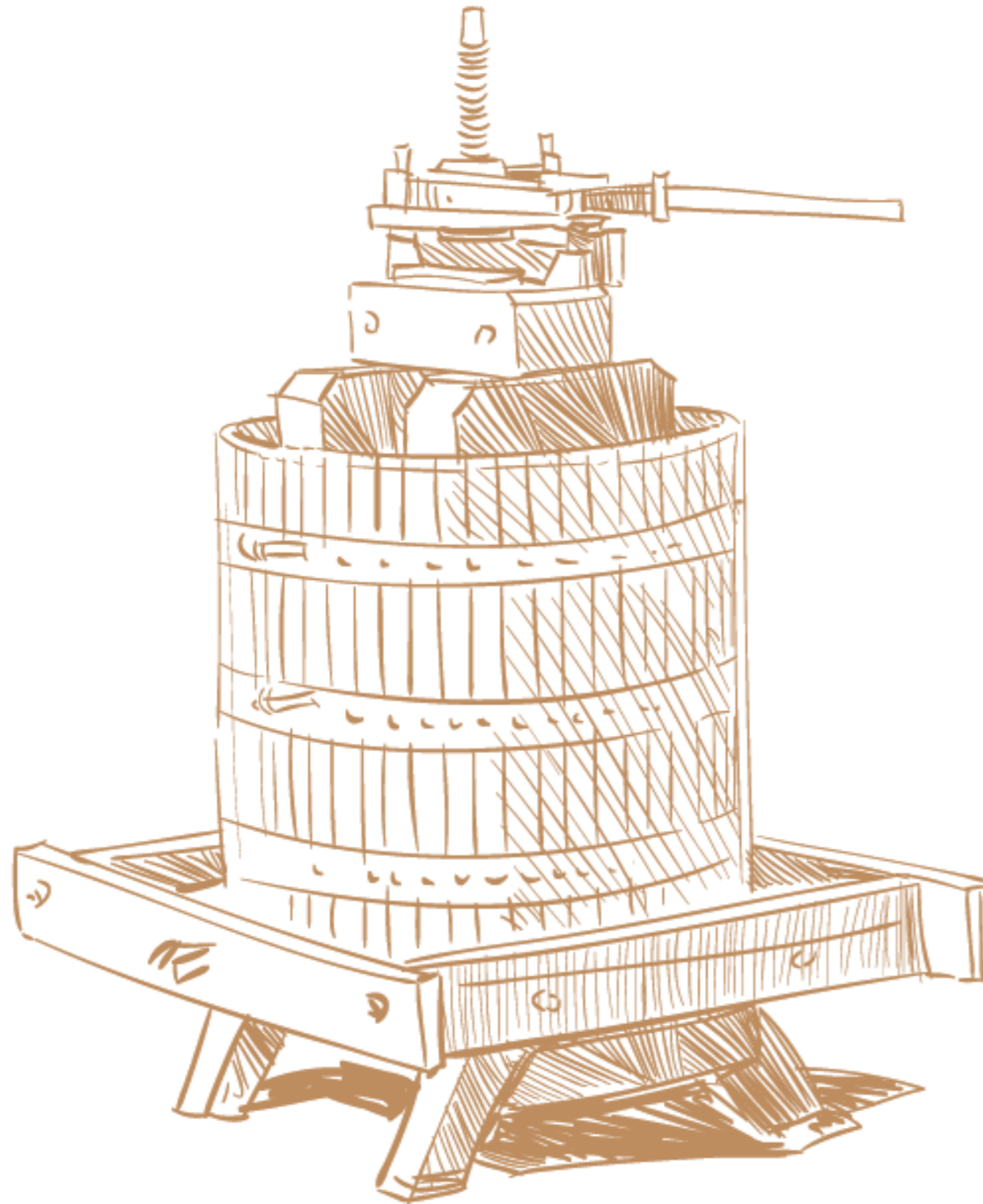

The ancient and mixed soil is made up of calcareous rock and galestro (marl) forcing the Sangiovese grape to bring out its best expression, resulting in complex and elegant wines: the iconic Brunello.

This site, among the hillsides of Piemonte, hosts an incredible biodiversity of wild flowers, native grasses, wildlife and an expansive truffle forest that infuses its beautiful microflora throughout our estate. Rooted in ancient limestone soils mixed with clay, sand and rock this site allows for wine of incredible expression, structure, vibrancy and elegance.

Ornellaia, Bolgheri DOC & Toscana IGT: Ornellaia has established itself among the iconic wine estates in Italy (and beyond). The estate is dedicated to producing charming and opulent wines, full of Mediterranean character and finesse, reflecting the estate's unique terroir in Bolgheri.

Tenuta Greppo Biondi-Santi, Brunello di Montalcino DOCG: Tenuta Greppo Biondi-Santi, Brunello di Montalcino DOCG: Biondi-Santi remains a beacon for traditionally made Rosso and Brunello di Montalcino. The Greppo vineyards of the Biondi Santi family date back to the 1800s. Clemente Santi, nephew of Giorgio Santi, was the first to create red wines suitable for ageing, and his oenological techniques learnt through agriculture, chemistry and science were far more advanced than his peers. Brunello del Greppo now has twenty five hectares dedicated to its production, and the traditional agronomy and cellaring practises are still used to give this grape its character and quality.

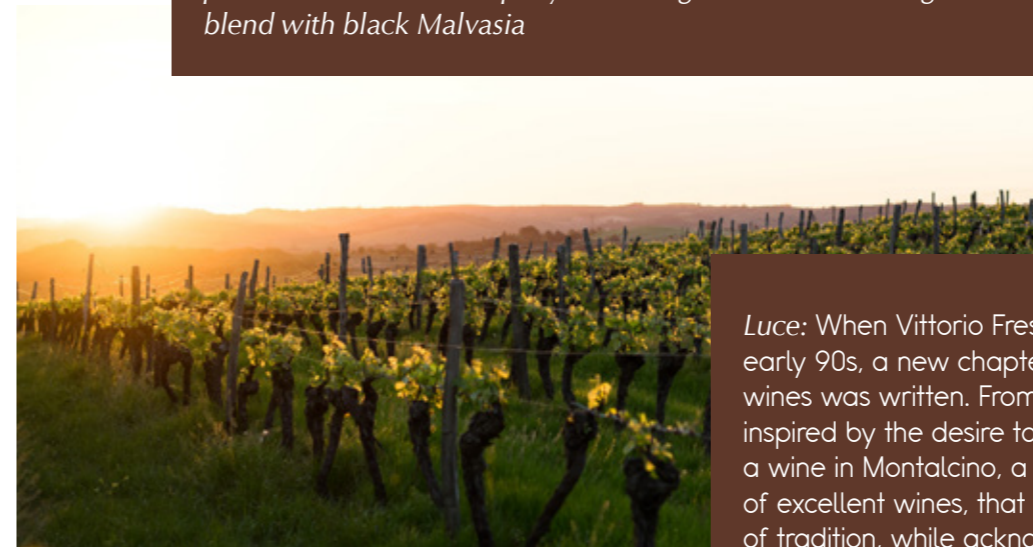

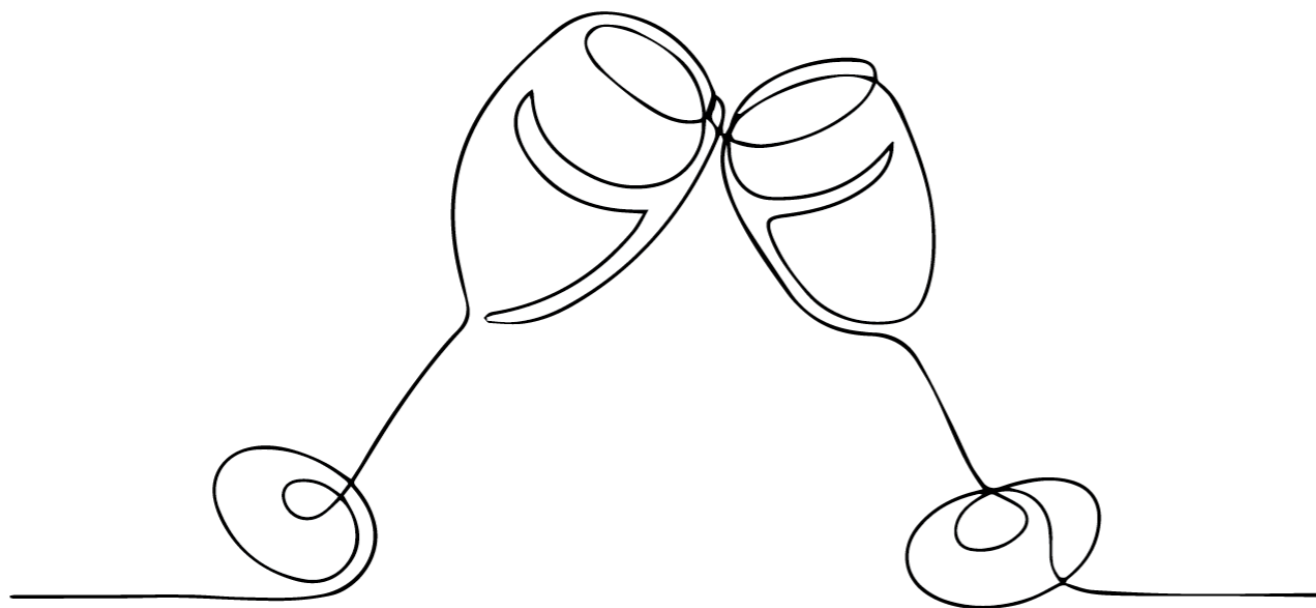

The Castellare di Castellina 2018 I Sodi di S. Niccolò shows the elegance and grace of these native grapes with aromas of red and purple fruit, cherry, wild rose and gardening soil. However, there is also a strong oak element that adds spice and toast to the bouquet and textural weight to the wine's generous build."

Castellare di Castellina: 80 hectares in the heart of the Chianti Classico area, close to the village of Castellina in Chianti. The hectares of vineyard are almost 33, located on the hills of a natural amphitheatre facing southeast. The production is of about 250.000 bottles of wine per year. The Sodi di S. Niccolò the most important Cru of Castellare, the pride of the Chianti company for having demonstrated the greatness of Sangiovese in blend with black Malvasia



Luce: When Vittorio Frescobaldi met Robert Mondavi in the early 90s, a new chapter in the history of the great Tuscan wines was written. From that meeting, a wine came to life inspired by the desire to make a dream come true: to create a wine in Montalcino, a land of choice for the production of excellent wines, that went beyond the boundaries of tradition, while acknowledging and celebrating it, by treasuring the experiences of two historic families in the world of wine.

Tentenublo, Viñaspre, Rioja:
Tentenublo is the project of Roberto Olivan who only began bottling wine in 2011. He's located in the village of Viñaspre which is in the foothills of the eastern end of the Cantabrian Mountains in Rioja Alavesa. His vineyard holdings are very fragmented with 26 tiny plots in total. Roberto inherited 6ha of vineyards from his Grandfather at the age of 16 and now has 8.5ha. His family has been growing grapes in the region for four generations but Roberto is the first to commercially release wine. He strives to make wines with fresh fruit and without excessive oak, chemicals or anything artificial.

Cota 45, Sanlucar: Ramiro Ibañez is passionate about the albariza soil and recovery of the traditional local grape varieties, many of these almost lost and also no longer permitted by the governing Consejo regulations. He makes wines that demonstrate the personality and terroir of each vineyard and grape variety without letting too much flor obscure it. He was a founding member of a group of like-minded local producers who wanted to experiment with old varieties and winemaking techniques, making unfortified Sherry and give more importance to the grapes and vineyard. All the wines are made in very small quantities and the current range is from the UBE project which is old vine Palomino from different clones fermented in old Manzanilla butt without flor.

Agricola Falset Marca, Montsant: This cooperative began in 1912 and joins over 250 families from the villages of Falset and Marca in the D.O. of Montsant. They have been producing their Vermouth the same way since 1912. Fascinatingly the white vermouth is made with a skin-contact orange wine and has been for over a century.

Whole bunch, fermented in open wooden vats. It is a serious, elegant and fresh Mencía, with a marked personality, it combines the mineral character of the Mencías del Bierzo with balsamic notes, violets and liquorice in the mouth we find red fruit, a solid weave of fine and defined tannins and a long journey in mouth.

Veronica Ortega: Originally from Cadiz, her love for the Mencía grape brought her to Bierzo in northwestern Spain. Since then, she's become a reference in the region and has blurred the lines between classic and natural Bierzo. Working mostly between the towns of Valtuille and Cobrana, she's making DO classified wine while also making villages and single vineyard style wines. Most of her vines are over 70 years old accounting for 5 total hectares spread across more than 20 small vineyards planted on a mix of clay, sand, and slate. Her grapes are a product of organic farming and her wines are made as naturally as possible only adding minimal doses of sulphur when needed to avoid deviations.

Bodegas Albamar: For Xurxo Alba and his family, working the land is a way of life. His family has been farming and making Albariño in the O Salnés sub-region of Rías Baixas for generations but it wasn't until Xurxo finished his oenological studies that they started bottling and commercializing their own wines in 2006. Albamar is one of only a handful of wineries in the region using natural yeasts for their fermentation, which has a dramatic impact on both the aromatics and flavour of albariño, giving the wines much more depth, complexity and interest.

4 Monos Viticultores: The Sierra de Gredos mountain range is 80km from Madrid and sits between 600m and 1200m in elevation. It is here that 4 Monos farm organically to produce beautifully transparent wines. 4 Monos (4 monkeys) is comprised of Javier Garcia (also head winemaker at Métrida icon Bodegas Jiménez-Landi), cowinemaker Laura Robles, wine-lover David Velasco, and vineyard holder David Moreno. Minimalism reigns supreme in their cellar and it is one of the cleanest we've ever seen. They harvest the Garnacha, Cariñena and Morenillo as soon as they achieve initial ripeness, and vinify using whole clusters, gentle extraction, long ferments (40+ days) and ageing in neutral oak of varying sizes.

Mas Que Vinos: Behind this small producer are three amazing personalities that each bring a little magic to this collaboration; Magarita Madrigal, Alexandra Schmedes and Gonzalo Rodriguez. They are all winemakers, and this is how they met many years ago in 1998 working as consultants in the magical wine region of Rioja. Mas Que Vinos is all about the indigenous varieties of the region; Cencibel (Tempranillo), Garnacha, Airén and Malvar. Organic farming practices and meticulous attention in the vineyard has resulted in some of the healthiest vines we've seen and this clearly impacts on the wines. The soil in the vineyards contain clay and limestone, sit at 750 metres or higher in altitude and the resulting wines express this terroir with lots of mineral vitality and energy.

Hofmann: Maria's daughter Carolin and her husband Jürgen Hofmann are now responsible for the wines. Both Jürgen and Carolin frequently commute from their family home in Appenheim in Rheinhessen to the wine growing estate on the Saar. The region's advantageous geological and climatic markers appear not just in Hofmann's Rieslings, but also his Grüner Silvaner, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay and Pinot varieties as well.

Willems Willems: Five generations of Willems women have managed the family's business. While today a dedicated wine growing estate, up until 1971 it was still operated as a mixed farm. That was the year Maria Willems married Karl, who shared a distant ancestor and thus the same last name. And so Willems became Willems-Willems, a name still proudly in use today. The wines are often described as "distinctive, independent Saar stars" that deliver an "appealingly gentle balance."

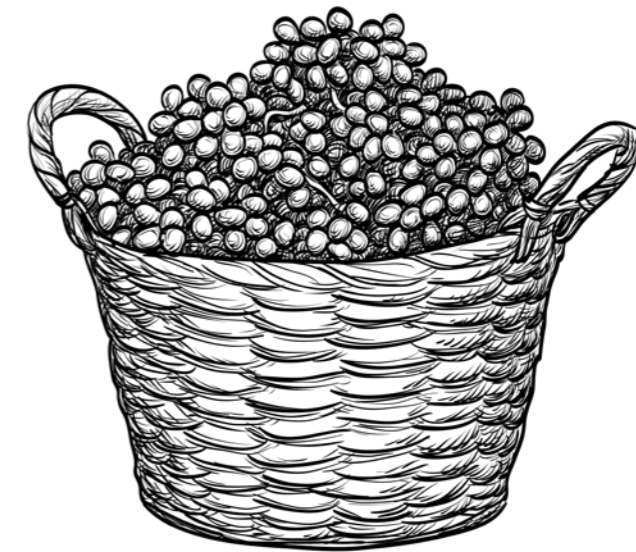

Deboutbertin: Stéphane and Vincent began this project in 2012 when they'd had enough of city life but were made keen about wine after biking through the Loire so decided to move to Faye d'Anjou. They work in a natural way without the use of pesticides, herbicides or chemical fertilizers in the vineyard or manipulation in the cellar, instead focusing on careful vineyard work and non-intervention during vinification. The bees wax capsule is a nice touch as well which follows their philosophy. They felt that given that they are trying to work so naturally, this was an obvious evolution. "All of our wines are made without additives. In the vineyards, everything is done by hand, except for the plowing which is done by our horse, Anatole". The wines are terroir driven and none contain added sulphur.

JURA

Domaine Pignier: Domaine Pignier's 37-acre vineyard covers the slopes of Montaignu in the Côtes du Jura appellation area. The vineyards sit at altitudes between 250m & 350m above sea level in the foothills of the Jura Mountains. Today the estate, which has been in the family since 1794, is in the hands of Maria Florence and her two brothers Antoine and Jean Etienne. The vineyards are cultivated biodynamically and they have been Demeter certified since 2003. The wines age in oak barrels in a 700-year-old cellar. They only make wine from fruit that they grow themselves. Being the only wine growers in the village, they are ideally placed to tend the vines organically and preserve the numerous strains of wild yeast present in the environment.

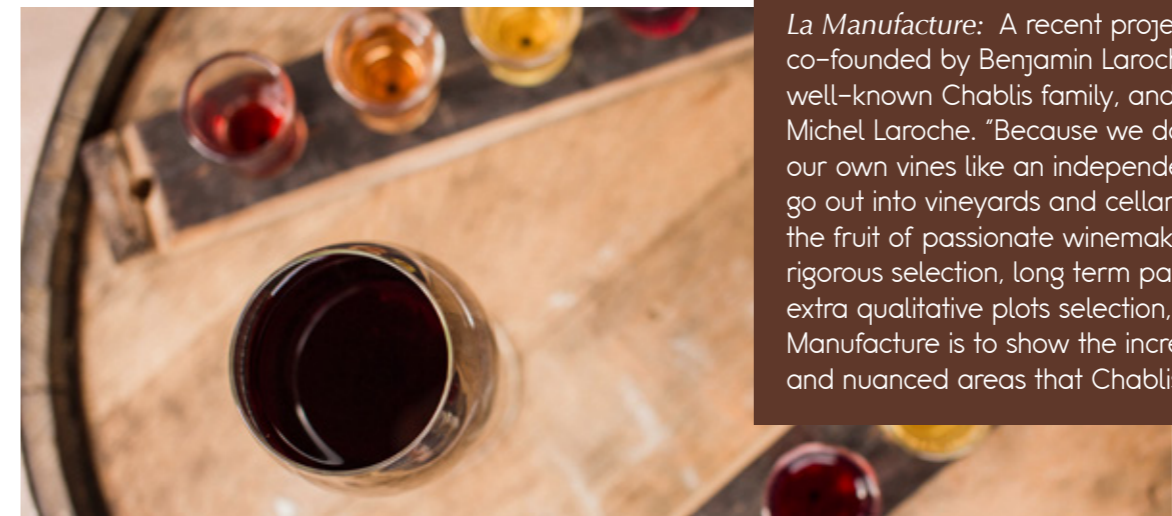

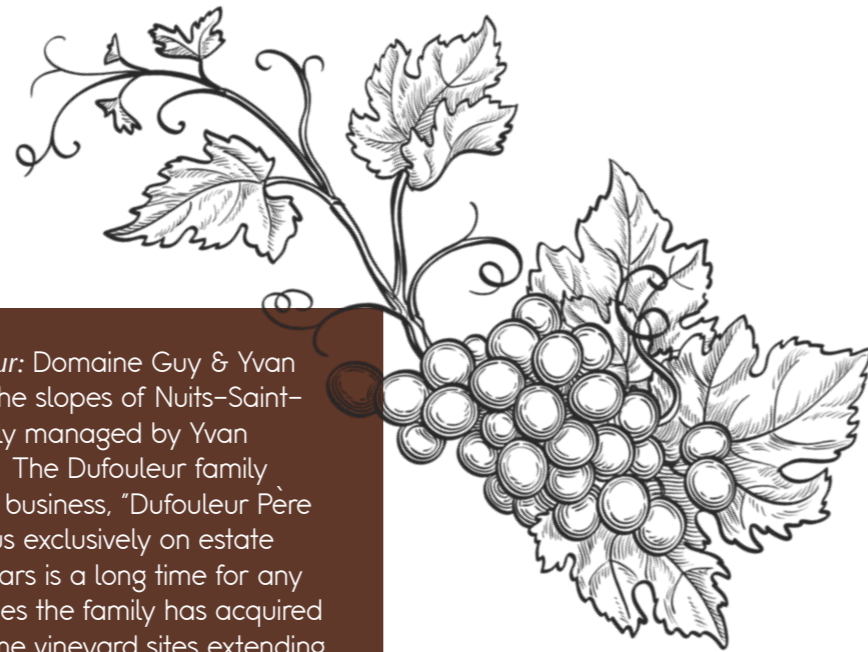

The Dufouleur family sold the negociant arm of their business, "Dufouleur Père et Fils," in 2006, wanting to focus exclusively on estate bottled wines. Four hundred years is a long time for any winery, and through the centuries the family has acquired a whopping 28 hectares of prime vineyard sites extending from Fixin to Santenay.

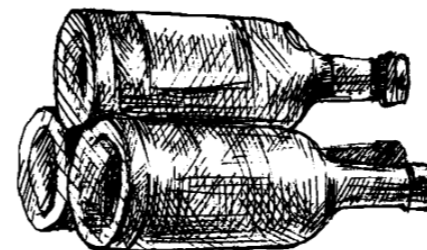

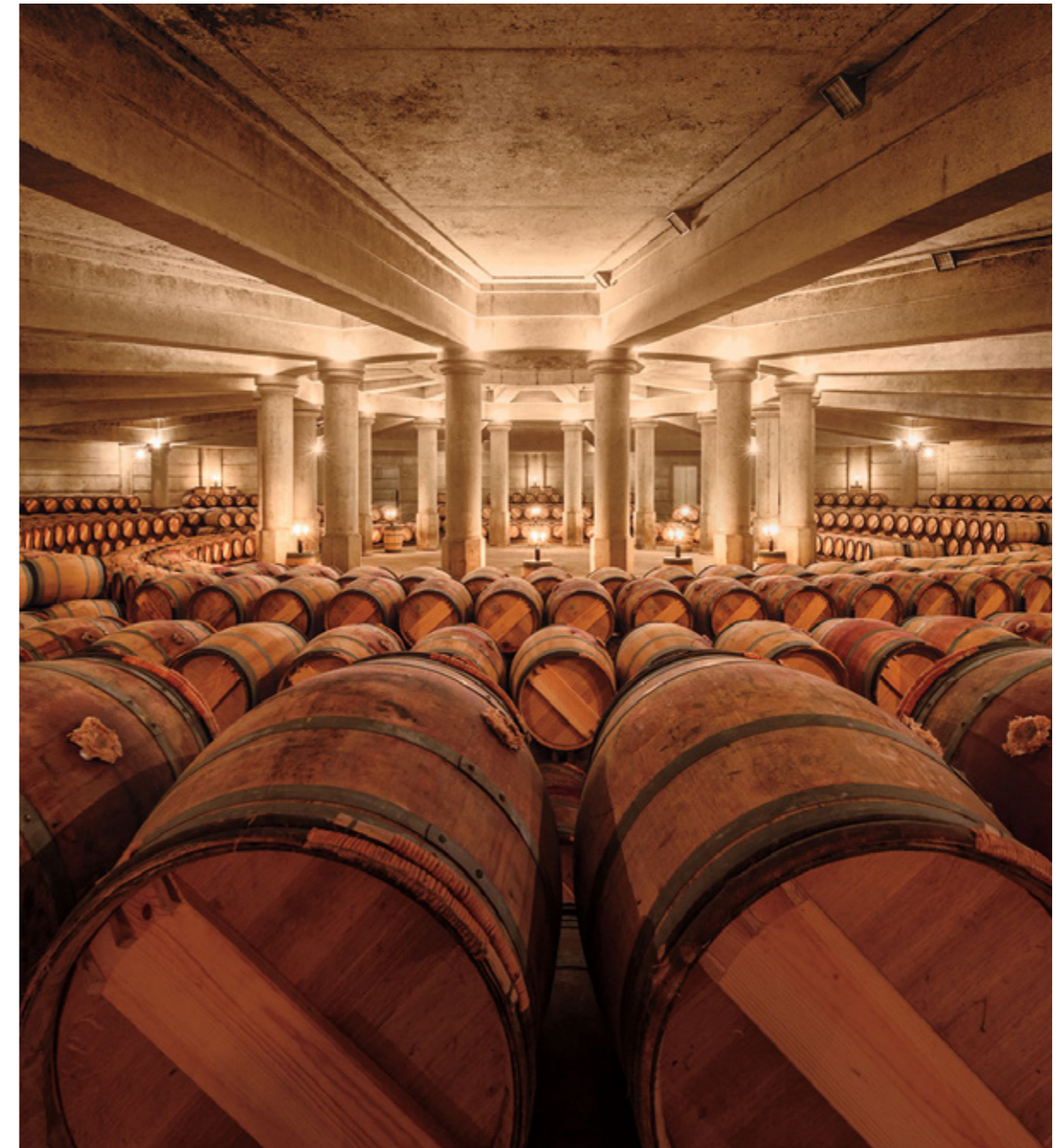

It waltzes out with flamboyant scents of wilted roses, star anise, mossy tree bark, and kirsch, leading to a core of blackcurrant pastille and stewed black plums. The full-bodied palate has a rock-solid structure of firm, grainy tannins and lively acidity supporting the densely packed, muscular black fruit, finishing incredibly long and with a spicy lift.
