The body of Messiah was placed in the tomb at the same time that the Passover lambs were being put into the ovens. During the afternoon of that 1st Passover day in Egypt, the father slaughtered a lamb to roast and eat that night, and applied the blood of the lamb to the door. His family stayed inside that night while the angel of death passed by. Nowadays, for us: Passover is Preparation Day: prepare tomorrow's meals today

Do no regular work today (Leviticus 23:6-7). The people of Israel left Egypt on this day—the Exodus from slavery.	Messiah's 1st night & 1st day in tomb. Chief priests and Pharisees met to set a watch over tomb (Mt. 27:62-66). The first Sunday after this date is Bikhurim: the Firstfruits of the Barley Harvest (Lev. 23:11). 50 days from Firstfruits is Shavuot (Pentecost; always on a Sunday, and a work day); the coming 49 days are Lag B'omer (Festival of Weeks/ Counting of the Omer).
