About This Course

What is Aromatherapy?

The controlled use of pure, natural aromatic oils obtained from plants to achieve good health through nature's chemistry.

Aroma meaning 'smell'

Therapy meaning 'massage' (as it's been traditionally known in the UK)

Essential oils can be prescribed for a range of conditions and applied topically and or used in compresses, inhalations, pessaries, suppositories and capsules.

Aims and Objectives

The **Aim** of the Diploma in Aromatherapy course is:

- To empower graduates with specialised practice-based knowledge of essential oils applied through Swedish style massage for the benefit of client care and safety through treatment planning, clinical prescribing and professional client charts.
- To provide opportunities for students to develop a range of skills and techniques, essential for successful blending, both topically and internally including natural product formulating and manufacturing.
- To provide graduates with chemistry knowledge to support reasons for prescribing and safe administering of plant based medicine to their clients.
- To explore the science around the growth, production and composition of essential oils
- To develop in-depth knowledge of essential oils, hydrosols and carrier oils and natural related products that support aromatic medicine
- To explore and develop an understanding of how to use organic plant compounds and the methods of making natural products

- To learn traditional styles of Aromatherapy massage sculptured for the needs of clients
- To understand pathology and prescription methodology for various systems of health

The **Objective** of the in Diploma in Aromatherapy course is:

- To provide purpose and meaning to 'Traditional Aromatherapy' practice in New Zealand. To consider this modality as an option to practice as a Professional Aromatherapist in the Complementary Medicine Sector.
- Who Should Do This Course?

- Those who are upskilling for professional practice and memberships as part of CPD (Continued Professional Development).

Practitioners with a Diploma in Aromatherapy will have the skill set to establish themselves in clinics that specialise in natural medicine, aromatherapy and massage.

Graduates can also gain employment in Salons, Health Clubs, Health Food shops, Spas and various aspects of the Complementary Medicine / Beauty Industry.

There may also be opportunities to work in midwifery, rehabilitation and palliative care.

Entry Requirements

Admission Requirements

- Open to New Zealand Citizens or Residents.
- Applicants must be a minimum of 16 years of age at commencement of study.
- Learners must have regular access to and use of a computer with reliable internet.
- Learners who have English as a second language are required to have an International English Test System (IELTS) score of 5 in the academic band, with no individual band score lower than 5; or equivalent.

What Qualification Do I Obtain?

- An ITEC qualification in Diploma in Aromatherapy for the Complementary Therapist and/or
- Aromatic Medicine Institute Diploma in Clinical Aromatherapy.

This is both internationally and nationally recognised with NZ standards of professional memberships and practice.

On completion of the Diploma learners may apply for membership with NZROHA (The New Zealand Register of Holistic Aromatherapists). This is the New Zealand Aromatherapy governing body **and** IFPA (The International Federation of Professional Aromatherapists) UK.

Intakes and Overview

Intakes

The Diploma in Aromatherapy course consists of **one** intake a year beginning in March.

You must attend in person at least three of the four week block courses held in Nelson.

These block courses are in:

March, May, August and October.

 The in Diploma in Aromatherapy course consists of approx. 1200 hours of learning.

Content and Structure

Content

- Includes but not limited to:
- Pure Essential Oils (learning over a 100 varieties).
- Foundation knowledge of aromatherapy (history and theory of essential oils).
- Methods of extracting oils.
- Key to Chemical Components of Essential Oils.
- Carrier Oils.
- The Art of Blending.
- Methods of Absorption
- Chemistry (Photosynthesis, Plant Families, chemo types, etc.).
- Special Topics.
- Health and Safety.

Structure

- The Diploma in Aromatherapy course is made up of four components:
 - Diploma in Aromatherapy 1 including Anatomy, Physiology & Pathology
 - Diploma in Aromatherapy 2 including Principles & Practice of Complementary Therapies
 - Diploma in Aromatherapy 3 including Provide Aromatherapy for Complementary Therapies
 - Diploma in Aromatherapy 4 including Business Practice for Complementary Therapies

Completions and Extensions:

- It is anticipated that, unless extenuating circumstances exist, the course will be completed in the set period, i.e. within 12 to 24 months from commencement of the course.
- In the event the course work has not been completed within the above timeframe, you may be granted an extension up to 1 year.
- Any learner granted a one-year determent during the first 6-month period must recommence study in the following year at the point of cessation.



Assessment Requirements

 Learners will need to have completed all four components showing competency in each.

The Examination Includes:

- A three-hour open book Diploma in Aromatherapy written exam
- One 1 hour ITEC multi choice exam in Anatomy, Physiology & Pathology
- A one hour ITEC practical full body Aromatherapy massage including the face.

Post Graduate Options

- Once learners have achieved the Diploma in Aromatherapy they may like to go on to other programmes of study i.e., Diploma in Reflexology for the Complementary Therapist.
- Please note, that ITEC units completed will be transferred to the next course. i.e. Anatomy & Physiology.
