Trim/finish detail for pillow cases and duvet covers



Linen Drawer products are tested to ensure *optimal durability* to withstand the frequent laundering and exposure in the hospitality industry.

The *tensile strength tests* show that the fabrics they use have between **29% and 71%** *more longevity* than the average results of competitor products tested.

These results are achieved through cotton fibre selection, yarn manufacturing, fabric construction and processing. Thread count is not an indication of quality and durability.
