#### Level 1 Behaviours

Not listening
Entering others' personal
space
Regular requests to leave the
classroom
Calling out
Inattentive
Off task
Unsafe use of equipment
Not wearing shoes
Riding scooter or bike in
school yard
Rough play
Not completing homework

### Low key responses

Reward peers showing positive behaviours Use non-verbal commands Reminder of appropriate behaviour

Apply logical consequences using 'Choice Language'

- Pause
- Use firm, neutral calm voice
- Give choice. One of two options.
- 4. Ask student for a response 'Please choose'
- Positive response 'Thank you'

Walk with the teacher Community service Redirect to another activity/spot

If behaviour continues see Level 2

#### **Level 2 Behaviours**

Non-compliant
Arguing with others
Distracting others
Rudeness or bad manners
Raised voice
Argumentative
Leaving class without
permission
Not following instructions
Refusing to complete work
Swearing
Littering

#### Possible consequences

Timeout
Learning time payback
Loss of extra-curricular
activities
Walk with the teacher
Practice appropriate
behaviour – Role play
Buddy class
Loss of next play time

# Ongoing level 1 and 2 behaviours:

Parents contacted by class teacher Community service Develop SMARTAR goals Introduced into behaviour monitoring system Restricted play

If behaviours continue see Level 3 consequences

#### **Level 3 Behaviours**

Ongoing level 1 and 2 behaviours Spitting at someone Vandalism Leaving school grounds Stealing Verbal abuse towards anyone Destruction of property Aggressive tone of voice and body language Inappropriate touching of self or others Physical violence Throwing objects at another Gender remarks/gestures Racial remarks or gestures Threatening others Bullying
