

Indonesian R-6 Term 1 Overview, 2025

Indonesian

Reception

- Students will begin to explore, with support, language features of Indonesian noticing similarities and differences between Indonesian and English.
- Students will learn about the Indonesian, Aboriginal, Torres Strait and Australian Flags. They will make their own Indonesian flag with different material and learn the colours that represent these flags.

<u>Year 1 & 2</u>

- Students will learn and use words, familiar phrases and modelled language to create spoken, written and multimodal texts.
- Students will work towards growing their vocabulary in the Indonesian language by being a part structured play base learning and collaborating with their peers.

Year 3 & 4

- Students will have the opportunity to create and share texts that represent elements of their identity, such as preferences, characteristics or strengths.
- Students will create an 'Tentang Saya' 'About Me' profile to share with the
 school.

Year 5 & 6

- Students will have the opportunity to compare some Indonesian language structures and features with those of English, using some familiar metalanguage.
- Towards the end of the term students will form a pen pal relationship with other students learning Indonesian at a different school.
