



## Room Term Overview 2024

<p><b>ENGLISH</b></p> <p>In English, the text focus for the term will be Persuasive and Poetic Play. Students will develop their knowledge and understanding of the appropriate text structures and language features. They will also develop an understanding of the purpose and audience for each text type. Our Class will explore phonics and phonological awareness of words to support their reading and spelling of a wider range of words.</p>	<p><b>MATHEMATICS</b></p> <p>In Mathematics, students will understand about 'Being a Mathematician', everyone uses mathematics in different ways in life and develop their understanding of the importance of sticking to a task, even when it is challenging, the power of mistakes and the importance of thinking deeply, not quickly. Students will also review and continue to build the concept of place value with whole numbers, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.</p>
<p><b>H.A.S.S.</b></p> <p>Civics and Citizenship Students will develop their understanding of the school values, rights and responsibilities, and the importance of rules and consequences of rules being followed and how individuals including themselves participate and contribute to their community. Students will also develop an understanding of celebrations, commemorations, emblems and symbols of Australia.</p>	<p><b>HEALTH EDUCATION</b></p> <p>Personal, Social and Community Health - Students will develop an understanding of personal and self-identity and the relationships with others within the school community and the importance of rights and responsibilities. The learning program will also include a focus on the two themes of the Child Protection Curriculum: The Right to be Safe.</p>
<p><b>TECHNOLOGIES</b></p> <p>In Technologies, students will explore a range of digital technology processes and production skills. They will learn how to plan, share and communicate ideas and information while applying agreed ethical and social protocols while using technology.</p>	<p><b>VISUAL/MEDIA ARTS</b></p> <p>Students will explore and experiment with elements of line, colour, shape and texture to develop individualised pieces of artwork in response to a given theme. We will also make personal evaluations of our own work and the artwork of others to extend our awareness of visual conventions. We will draw on artworks and techniques from a range of cultures, times, locations and technologies.</p>
