

All of the recipes in this book are grounded in Asian flavors and made with a combination of American, European, and Asian baking techniques—all made with accessibility in mind. Featuring stunning photography by Evan Sung, this book will have a visual-forward focus and an emphasis on fun-loving design. Divided into three major chapters, Bao, Dessert, and Snacks, with subcategories for

easy navigation, *Breaking Bao* is designed with both the trained and home baker in mind. In the Bao chapter, readers will learn the fundamentals of baking bao, whether it be baked, steamed, fried, or laminated, and then will go on to discover delicious and unexpected bao-based recipes. The Dessert chapter will have readers honing their baking skills, and in the final chapter, Snacks, readers will make all kinds of savory and sweet treats. *Breaking Bao*'s technique-driven approach and its wonderful recipes will demystify Asian baking for those who are unfamiliar and bring back fond memories for those who have known and loved these flavors for many years.

Clarice Lam initially began her career in modeling, which gave her the opportunity to travel internationally for over a decade. Her time in Paris ignited a deep appreciation for the world of French pastry. While living in Italy, Lam attended Le Cordon Bleu where she took courses in Italian cuisine. After retiring from modeling, Lam returned to the United States where she studied at The French Culinary Institute and graduated with a Grand Diplôme in Classic Pastry Arts. Her work has been featured in The New York Times, Food & Wine, Condé Nast Traveler, and many more. Lam made her on-camera debut on Amazon Prime Video's Dr. Seuss Baking Challenge as a main judge, which premiered in December 2022.
