Once there was a boy named Willie. His parents named him Willie because every time they gave him something to eat they said, "Willie (will he) like it?"


They gave him a hamburger and said, "Will he like it?" Willie took one bite and said "Willie likes it!!!"

They gave him a tortilla with melted cheese and said, "Will he like it?" Willie took one bite and said, "Willie likes it!"


They gave him a peanut butter and jelly sandwich and said, "Will he like it?" Willie took one bite and said "Willie likes it!!"


"What's the matter with these foods? Willie likes them!" Willie's parents said.


