






- 1. Plug GFCI into receptacle.

- 4. Press reset button to use product. Do not use if the button fails to disable fan.






## **Climbing Patterns**


There are four different ways to scale the rockwall, some more challenging than others. Follow this color-coded foothold guide to try them all:

Follow RED - challenge level 1 (difficult)


Follow YELLOW - challenge level 2 (moderately difficult)


Follow GREEN - challenge level 3 (moderately easy)













## **Repair Kit Instructions**





In the event of an accidental puncture, cut out a section of material that is larger than puncture (See figure 1).

The material should be cut in circle or have rounded corners to prevent patch from peeling (See figure 2).

Make sure area is properly cleaned. Rubbing alcohol may be used to clean surface. Apply the glue to the back surface of the patch. Place patch over puncture and press firmly to obtain proper adhesion. Do not inflate the unit for at least 1 hour.
