Who is it for?

Everyone! Safe for color treated hair and daily use.

Method of Use:

Apply evenly all over damp or dry hair. 2 pumps for short hair, 3-4 pumps for longer hair. Used on wet or dry hair, it smoothes, adds fullness and shine, and helps hold natural-looking styles.

For curly and wavy hair; it's an excellent curl setter, contributing tightness and bounce without stickiness.

<u>Straight</u>: When used on straight hair with a blow dryer, it helps blowouts look their best and last their longest.

Key Ingredient features:

Pracaxi Seed Oil: Increases softness, brightness and shine

Sweet Almond Protein: Moisturizes and provides thermal protection

Pracaxi Seed Oil (certified organic, Brazil) is one of nature's gifts to humans. It is found in the lowland Tropics in South America from northeastern Venezuela through the Guianas, including Trinidad and Tobago, and into Amazonia. The oil of the seed is rich in behenic acid, a long chain acid that promotes wet comb compatibility, increases hair brightness and shine.

Dicaprylyl Carbonate is derived from coconut and palm oils and Ecocert approved. Used as an emollient, it gives the product a light texture and produces a soft after-feel in the hair.

Chitosan Succinamide is derived from the French mushroom Agaricus bisporus. A natural polysaccharide, it delivers a silky touch with the added benefit of protecting hair from pollution.

Butyrospermum Parkii (Shea Butter) known in West Africa and Europe as karite, is a well known ingredient; it infuses moisture into the hair, creating softness and manageability. Our shea butter is pure and high quality. The use of chemical free processes mean it is naturally high in shea olein and therapeutic unsaponifiables, unlike other more refined alternatives. The producers of this shea butter are women farmers belonging to farming groups and cooperatives of northern Uganda and Southern Sudan. Our support of these producers increases the value of the living shea tree, engendering conservation of indigenous African woodland for future generations.

Apply 1-3 drops, depending on hair density and length. Warm into palms and massage onto dry or damp hair.

<u>Soft / Fine</u> - we recommend that Ever be used as a night treatment, or as an added booster to conditioner. If used as a daily styling addition, apply only 1 drop to damp hair and style as usual.

<u>Curly / Dense</u> - use alone or in addition to MILK for added moisture and hair taming capabilities. Ever performs beautifully when used to straighten curly hair.

<u>Color Treated / Damaged</u> - Use EVER daily to repair and strengthen hair, focusing on the ends. At night- fully saturate the hair from root to end with EVER for a luxurious night treatment and wash as usual the next day.

Key Ingredient features:

Marula Serum: High in Omegas- 6 and 9 fatty acids this miracle worker seals, coats and smoothes the hair cuticle resulting in a satin shine with a non-greasy finish.

Crambe Abyssinica: High in Omega 9 fatty acids, intensely nourishing, able to penetrate hair shaft to seal in moisture and adds elasticity to the hair.

Squalane: Naturally occurring in the human body, sustainably derived from Olives, protects hair from color degradation, reduces thermal damage and tames frizz.



Marula Serum the key ingredient in this serum, is produced from nuts harvested from trees growing on a wild track of East Africa from Kenya into Tanzania.

The nut is inside a delicious edible fruit that contains high amounts of vitamin C as well as other antioxidants. Women harvest the fallen fruit, removing it to make juice, jams, and delicious marula liqueur.

After using the fruit, the nuts are sun dried. The oil-rich kernels are extracted by cracking the hard casing and carefully removing each piece by hand using tiny picks. Quality inspection of each kernel is essential for producing the finest marula oil. Processing takes place in small batches by pressing and filtering the oil using high-quality presses and filtering equipment.

Of all the uses of the Marula tree, it is the oil that has brought spiritual status because of its healing properties. Marula oil contains between 70-78% skin and hair compatible omega nine fatty acids. It is a monounsaturated high-oleic acid that, unlike omega 3 and 6, is also produced in the human skin. Research is still ongoing to determine why marula oil has such exceptional stability. It is thought to be due to its unique fatty acid profile along with a variety of potent antioxidants that scientists suspect have not been fully identified. Tocopherols, sterols, and flavonoids, procyanidin, galattotannin and catechins are also found in Marula Oil.

Crambe Abyssinica is a renewable and sustainable plant hailing from the Mediterranean region and parts of eastern Africa, this hardy plant produces a seed oil which has some very unique properties. With a highly biodegradable profile, Crambe Abyssinica is often compared to Jojoba Oil. Crambe Abyssinica Seed Oil is higher in Erucic Acid. For the hair, this means a strong concentration of intensely nourishing Omega 9, a non-essential fatty acid. As a very stable and long lasting seed oil it rapidly penetrates the outer layers of the follicle deeply nourishing the hair while providing a smooth, soft layer of protection against dehydration.

Squalane is naturally occurring in the human body, but ours is sustainably derived from olives. Squalane has long been used in high-end cosmetics and boasts a myriad of benefits for the skin. In addition to Squalanes ability to protect hair from color degradation and thermal damage, we chose to use Squalane in EVER because of the oils light-as-air feeling. Squalane allowed us to create a hair oil that even those with fine hair could use.

Hydrolyzed lupine protein is an active ingredient obtained from organic sweet white lupine that boosts cellular activity, improves barrier function, and protects against skin damage and environmental stress. The protein penetrates down to the basal layers of the epidermis where it reinforces the natural resurfacing systems within the skin. By stimulating cellular activity, it renews the stratum corneum and boots epidermal hydration. Clinical studies demonstrate up to a 13% reduction in trans epidermal water loss (TEWL) after 14 days of use. The result is smoother more hydrated scalp that is repaired and regenerated.

Malus domestica fruit cell culture extract is derived from a rare and endangered Swiss apple, the Uttwiler Spatlauber. This particular variety of apple is known for its ability to maintain freshness over long periods of time. Rich in proteins and other nutrients, its long-living cells have been a subject of much research. This has resulted in the development of a relatively new technology that enables the extraction and cultivation of specific meristem cells, the plant's stem cells. A chosen part of the plant is wounded. Specific cells are stimulated to form callus cells that heal the wound. These active cells have the ability to dedifferentiate to create new tissue when they are needed. In order to harvest the cells yet not further endanger the plant, a way of sustainably cultivating the cells was also developed. Now, extracts of otherwise rare, actively potent plant cells can be used in cosmetics. Rich in epigenetic factors and metabolites, when used on the skin or scalp, the apple extract helps assure the longevity of the human stem cells and their own regenerative properties. The effects result in protection and longevity of skin stem cells, delaying senescence of essential cells, combating chronological aging and preserving the vitality of your scalp.

Cassia angustifolia seed polysaccharide is extracted from the seeds of Indian senna, a plant commonly used in Ayurveda. This ingredient has a structure similar to hyaluronic acid. It forms a film on the skin and attracts water to help protect, moisturize, and even restructure and soften skin. In vivo studies show improvements in complexion more than three times that of hyaluronic acid, when used at 3%. Scalp is more supple and moisturized, even a full day after use.

Rose and Rosemary flower waters are hydrosols are the phyto-nutrient rich, delicately- scented waters resulting from the steam distillation process used to produce essential oils. Rose water has been used as a soothing aid for centuries to protect and preserve the skin. Rosemary is a revitalizer and its scent restores energy and alertness. Rosemary is famous for restoring healthy, scalp and luxuriously shiny hair.

Bergamot possesses a complexity and fullness, and when combined with Italian Neroli, it exudes the elegant Mediterranean style. Spicy, warm notes of sandalwood and cardamom recall the romance of ancient trade routes. Warm vanilla and balsam weave in and out of play with sultry jasmine.

Essential Oils And Their Origins

Bergamot, from the sunny Italian Calabrian coast, is squeezed from the rind of the citrus fruit. The essential oil's delicious complexity is a favorite in perfumes, confections, pipe tobacco, and teas.

<u>Black Pepper Oil</u> from Madagascar, an island continent off the southeast coast of Africa, is produced by a family-owned farm in a labor-intensive process of harvesting, drying, hand-cleaning, and steam distilling. The pepper vines, supported by "bois noir" (acacia) trees, grow up to thirty feet. The vines and the acacia trees also provide shade to coffee plants. <u>Clove and Ginger</u> from the same Malagasy plantation, add an exotic warmth and harmony to the blend.

<u>Bourbon Vanilla</u> from Madagascar is considered the finest in the world. Ours is the first vanilla to be processed in Madagascar by a Malagasy-owned company.

Bulgarian Rose Otto, or Rosa damascena is renowned for its unique, euphoric, intoxicating quality. It is one of the most expensive elements in the finest fragrances. The finest quality comes from the fields of Bulgaria. 2000 lbs of rose handpicked rose petals produce 1 lb of essential oil. Rose is highly prized and used with utter respect for its dollar value and for its therapeutic value. The calming benefits of rose oil have been known for thousands of years.

Situated in the foothills of the Alps above Torino, is a farmer/distiller who represents the fifth generation to work his family-owned farm, producing **fennel oil** as well as other therapeutic essential oils.

Frankincense is a wild Boswellia carteri from Oman. It is rich and full with a lemon twist in its scent. Frankincense is called for in many ancient and medieval recipes, and is the most commonly found ingredient in incense blends. The liquid oil is used in many blends and in skin care to rejuvenate the skin and combat the effects of aging. Our frankincense is processed by supercritical carbon dioxide (CO2) extraction; 10 to 12 kilos of raw material yields one kilo of extract. Frankincense at one time was considered more valuable than gold, revered as holy anointing oil along with myrrh. Frankincense was widely used for medicinal purposes to treat skin disease, nervous system imbalances and digestive disruption, and was listed as a medicinal and aromatic plant in the ancient Egyptian record, Ebers Papyrus. Frankincense is perhaps best known for its calming and sedative effects on the mind and central nervous system, making it ideal for meditation.

<u>Jasmine Sambac</u> comes from India where flowers are hand-picked at the break of dawn in ritual style. Women in traditional dress, proudly sing as they gather the tiny flowers one-by-one.

Lavandin from France is a hybrid of lavender. Its scent is clean and refreshing and reminiscent of the classical French laundry.

The <u>Nobel Bay Laurel</u> from Hungary, revered even in ancient times, is the first choice of healers for many ailments due to its antibacterial and regenerative properties. Laurus nobilis is said to slow physical aging and the weakening of the mental processes.

<u>Patchouli</u> from Sumatra, is said to help relieve depression and anxiety. The oil has diuretic properties and helps strengthen the supporting cellular network of the skin. By stimulating the regeneration of skin cells, it is beneficial for a healthy scalp which promotes hair growth.

Palmarosa Essential Oil from the leaves and flower tops of palmarosa has a sweet, slightly citrus scent that calls to mind both geranium and rose. A native grass, palmarosa grows wild from the southern subtropical slopes of Nepal to the serene Himalaya Mountains. Produced by steam distillation of the fresh or dried grass, palmarosa may be a lesser known essential oil, but it is superlative for skin care, offering cell regenerative and antiseptic properties beneficial to dry, mature, and problem skin types. While palmarosa soothes the skin, it is also uplifting to the spirit, reducing nervous tension and stress, clearing the mind, and calming the senses. The Nepalese name the plant Motiya, and have capitalized on its benefits to create economic opportunities. By providing a guaranteed market for cultivated and wild- collected plants, cooperative programs help small-scale local farmers continue to work the fields, as well as promote the protection of open space for business purposes by leasing privately owned and community lands. Cultivation and harvest are organic and sustainable: What remains from the distillation process is composted and returned to the lands to encourage fertile soil. Micro-financing is available to help local people begin to farm and to provide them with the knowledge to properly cultivate and harvest the plants. Not only can plants like bountiful palmarosa provide therapeutic benefits to people worldwide, they also offer rural residents consistent employment and cash earnings, thereby raising quality of life.

<u>Sage</u> brings potent healing powers. Our sage oil comes from the plant's birthplace, the rocky Adriatic islands dotting the Dalmatian Coast of Croatia. It is known therapeutically as the "saving" herb.

<u>Sandalwood</u> from Australia lends a honey-sweet, woody and dry scent to the essential oil blend in this product. It is often used in meditation and has a sedative effect.

<u>Spearmint</u> from the Willamette Valley of Oregon is the sweet mint, originating in Greece. Its name is mentioned in recipes for liturgical perfumes found on the walls of Egyptian temples of Horus at Edfou.

<u>Vetiver Oil</u> comes from the root of a type of grass that grows in many tropical countries. Ours is from Indonesia. In a land in dire need of environmental protection, the grass is planted to help protect the deforested hillsides from erosion. Its scent is earthy and sultry.
