





The Chaplet of Divine Mercy

Begin by making the sign of the cross while holding the crucifix. Then pray one Our Father, one Hail Mary and one Apostle's Creed

On the Our Father Beads recite the following: Eternal Father, I offer Thee the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On the Hail Mary Beads recite the following: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

In conclusion, say this prayer three times: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

End this prayer by making the sign of the cross: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

The Lord's promises attached to The Chaplet of Divine Mercy:

"The souls that say this chaplet will be embraced by My Mercy during their lifetime and especially at the hour of their death." (Diary, 754)... "When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their hearts with peace and the hour of their death will be a happy one." (Diary, 1541)... When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as a just judge but as a Merciful Savior." (Diary, 1541)... "Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death." (Diary, 687)... "Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy." (Diary, 687)
