FRENCH KNITTER


FLOWER KIT



Morris Sons

1° STEP

Using the French Knitter, create an i-cord approximately 75cm long (make it longer for a larger flower).



2° STEP

Leave a long tail at the end of the cord for sewing up the ends to prevent unravelling. Ensure the tail is long enough for hanging the flower.

3° STEP

Use a yarn needle and yarn from the end of the cord to stitch the flower, shaping the petals as you go.



4° STEP

Cut a small circle template from paper for the flower's center and use it to cut a circle from felt.




5° STEP

Have an adult pre-punch a hole in the center of the felt. Use the needle to sew the circle onto the flower, threading the needle in between each petal.

6° STEP


Cut a larger circle for the back and have an adult pre-punch a center hole (using a sharp needle) and five holes for the thread to go between the petals



7° STEP

Use a tapestry needle and cotton to sew the back circle on, going through the center hole and then through the center of each petal.





8° STEP

Once finished, bring the cotton thread through the center hole to the front. Ask an adult to help you make a knot close to the felt. Cut the cotton about 1.5cm long.
