



Pomegranate Gimlet with BG Reynolds Lush Grenadine

Home Cocktail Kit

Ingredients

2 oz Aria Portland Dry Gin
 $\frac{3}{4}$ BG Reynolds Grenadine
 $\frac{3}{4}$ Fresh Lime Juice

Instructions

Have fun with this simple basic drink by experimenting with different syrups, adding bitters, or even replacing the syrup with a flavored liqueur.

To make a classic Gimlet, replace the grenadine syrup with simple syrup.

To make the best tasting drinks possible, always use freshly squeezed citrus. Never substitute mixes, concentrates, or pre-squeezed juice.

Slice a lime in half perpendicular to its axis.

Slice a thin wheel from one side of the lime and set aside

Squeeze and collect the juice from the lime halves.

In a cocktail shaker;

Measure and add syrup.

Measure and add lime juice.

Measure and add Aria Gin.

Fill shaker with ice.

Shake violently and aggressively for about 30 seconds.

Strain contents of shaker into a chilled cocktail glass.

Cut a slit through the peel of the lime wheel and hang the lime on the side of the cocktail glass. You can also float the lime on top of the drink if you prefer.
