



OFF-LICENCE – REMOTE SALES

Section 17 to 20, and 64 Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **LAKE ROAD GROUP LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell from the premises situated at **73 Main Road, Gisborne**, and known as "**Lake Road Wines**", to **any person for consumption off the premises**.

Section 40 applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day
2. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Any time and on any day
3. Sales of alcohol are restricted to grape, fruit, and vegetable wines.
4. The whole of the premises is regarded as **undesignated**.
5. Any website that the licensee uses to sell alcohol remotely must display an image or link to an image of this licence.
6. In the case of remote sales; the licensee must ensure that the requirements of section 59 of the Act are met at all times.

This licence is assessed as an Off-Licence, Winery Cellar Door (remote sales only), and the fee payable was \$368.00.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force

1. Either
 - i. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
2. If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either
 - I. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - II. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

This licence expires on **11 October 2025**
