
## Together we can do more

### WHAT WE DO

The Better Future Collective has been founded to bring together brands who work in India and wan't to make a difference socially.

Through our collective we raise funds to give girls who live in Luniyawas, an impovrished area in Jaipur, the chance to go to school.

The school we work with is called Sneh Girls Shikshan Sansthan and their mission is to provide free quality education in a safe and secure environment for girls that otherwise would not get to go. Girls education is often seen as less important and in poor families where help is needed at home, many girls do not get given the opportunity to go to school. We wan't to help change that.

## How we work

We are looking for 'Aunties' or 'Uncles'. Each girl needs one Auntie or Uncle who will sponsor her for a year at the SGSS.

To sponsor one girl for one year at SGSS it costs just £160

This includes:

Tuition fees, food, uniform, stationary, note books and school bag.

To be part of the collective we are asking for a minimum sponsorship of 3 girls (total £480).

If you feel you can afford more than of course it would be very much welcomed!!

She is hugely passionate about the amazing work Ramesh's foundation does and advocates for it.

Daisy visits the school regularly and is able to organise school visits to any 'Aunties' or 'Uncles' whilst they are in Jaipur.
