

Prayers to be said upon the arrival of Mashiach

L'iluy nishmat
Liel Dina bat Ephraim a'h

1. When we first hear from a reliable source the good news of *mashiach's* arrival, we will recite, "*Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech haolam hatou veahameitiv.*" "*Baruch Attah Hashem ga'al Yisrael*".
 2. When we see the huge throngs of Jews assembled to greet him, which will no doubt number at least 600,000 people, we will recite, "*Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech ha'olam chacham harazim.*"
 3. When we actually see the mashiach, we will recite
"Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech haolam shechalak mikevodo lirei'au."
- Immediately after reciting this beracha, we will recite the beracha "*Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech ha'olam shechalak meichachmaso lirei'au.*"
4. When we see the rebuilt Beis HaMikdash one should recite,
"Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech ha'olam matziv gvul almanah."
 5. When the dead are revived, we will recite
"Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech haolam mechayeh hametim."
