

Prayers to be said upon the arrival of Mashiach

L'iluy nishmat
Liel Dina bat Ephraim a'h

1. When we first hear from a reliable source the good news of *mashiach's* arrival, we will recite, "*Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech ha'olam hatov vehameitiv.*" "*Baruch Attah Hashem ga'al Yisrael.*"

2. When we see the huge throngs of Jews assembled to greet him, which will no doubt number at least 600,000 people, we will recite, "*Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech ha'olam chacham harazim.*"

3. When we actually see the *mashiach*, we will recite "*Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech ha'olam shechalak mikevodo lirei'av.*"

Immediately after reciting this beracha, we will recite the beracha "*Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech ha'olam shechalak meichachmaso lirei'av.*"

4. When we see the rebuilt Beis HaMikdash one should recite, "*Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech ha'olam matziv guul almanah.*"

5. When the dead are revived, we will recite "*Baruch Attah Hashem Elokeinu Melech ha'olam mechayeh hametim.*"
