

## **Frail Phil Collins, 67, supports wife Orianne, 45, at her high-end jewellery store opening in Miami... as she unveils **DRAMATIC** transformation**

- Phil and Orianne famously announced they were reconciling in 2016, eight years after their shock £25million divorce settlement
- He announced his comeback tour in October 2016 after a ten year break but suffered a fall on the way to the bathroom a year later
- The singer was forced to cancel the shows and reschedule them for November
- Orianne, 45, suffered a paralysing back injury in December 2014 following an operation to treat a slipped disc in her back but appeared in better health
- Phil helped to nurse Orianne back to health and they got back together. The couple are parents to son Nicholas, 16, and Matthew, 13
- The pop star is currently on his comically named I'm Not Dead Yet tour and performs from a chair - he will tour the US from October

A frail Phil Collins turned up to support his beloved wife, Orianne, at the grand opening of her **Miami** jewellery store on Thursday.

The 67-year-old musician was casually dressed as he stood with the aid of a stick following his recent health woes, as he stood proudly by his glamorous spouse.

Orianne, 45, unveiled a dramatic transformation on the day, wearing a glitzy silver mini dress and Chanel boots, carrying a silver quilted Chanel bag.
