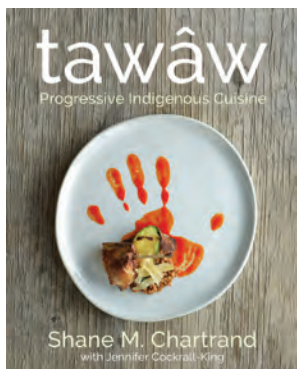

### BRAISED VENISON SHANKS WITH MOSSBERRY BLACK GARLIC GLAZE AND HERBED WHEAT BERRIES

SERVES 4 TO 6 PEOPLE

Wild game is usually more flavorful but a little tougher than domesticated animals. Braising, which is cooking in a small amount of liquid in a pot with a tight-fitting lid, helps make tender, juicy meat. It's a classic method for cooking game shanks of any kind, so never skimp. The most and warmest flavor of the black garlic glaze will be in the shank, so the wheat berries are really just along for the ride. You'll need to cook the wheat berries separately before adding them.

After your meal, save the shank bones. You can use the bones to enrich the next time you make this, stuffing them with whatever herbs or garnishes you like.

#### FOR THE WHEAT BERRIES

1 cup (250 mL) wheat berries  
1 cup (250 mL) water  
2 to 4 cups (500 to 1,000 mL) game  
1/2 cup (125 mL) salt  
1/2 cup (125 mL) oil

#### FOR THE BRAISED VENISON SHANKS

4 venison shanks, all-pieces bone  
1/2 cup (125 mL) oil  
1/2 cup (125 mL) butter  
4 x 1 1/2 lbs (2 x 750 g) deer shanks (bone in)

## LIVE SCALLOP CEVICHE

*Firm, with rich flavors, scallops can stand up to a lot of treatments, but sometimes I just want to let the fish speak for itself.*

4 live scallops, shucked from the shell and cleaned (see page 82)  
 1 medium white onion, finely diced  
 200 ml (1½ cups) fresh lime juice  
 1 Anaheim or serrano chili pepper, seeded and minced  
 ½ bunch fresh cilantro, stems and leaves separated, roughly chopped  
 Juice from 1 grapefruit  
 45 ml (1.5 fl.oz) cane sugar  
 1 grapefruit, peeled and cut into small chunks  
 High-quality olive oil  
 Finishing salt (Fleur de Sel, not iodized)

In a non-reactive bowl, combine scallops, onion, and lime juice. Cover and refrigerate for about 3 hours.

Transfer marinated scallops to a cutting board. To the onion and lime juice mixture, add chili, coriander stems, grapefruit juice, and sugar. Set aside.

Using a sharp knife, cut each scallop horizontally into 4 equal rounds or “coins.” Fan each sliced scallop over a small serving plate. Spoon chili mixture overtop and around the scallop. Garnish with grapefruit pieces and coriander leaves. Drizzle with olive oil, and dust with finishing salt.

*Serves 4 to 6 as an appetizer.*

### STEPS

- 1 Pour the almonds into a bowl, cover with water, and let them soak for at least 1 hour.
- 2 In a food processor, combine the almonds and dates and process until the mixture is smooth enough to slip together when you press it between your fingers. Press the mixture into the bottom and sides of 8 Mason jar lids to make small crusts. Set aside.
- 3 Place all the filling ingredients in a blender and blend until smooth. Divide the mixture evenly among the crusts.

### INGREDIENTS

2. In the microwave on High, cook the prosciutto slices on paper towel for 4 minutes, or until they're crisp. Chop the cooked prosciutto, then add it to a bowl, along with the remaining topping ingredients. Stir well.

3. Sprinkle the mixture over the melon slices. Done.
