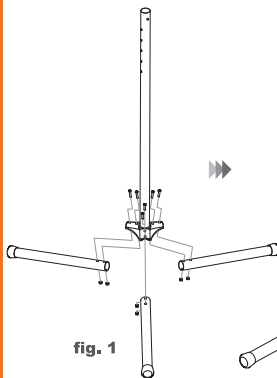
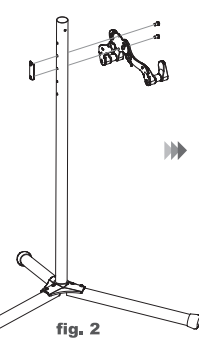


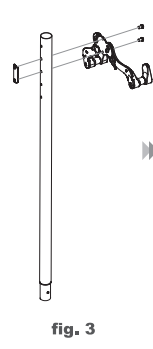
**1. Assemble Legs to Lower Post**



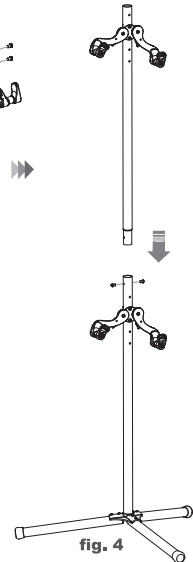
**2. Assemble Lower Hanger to Lower Post**



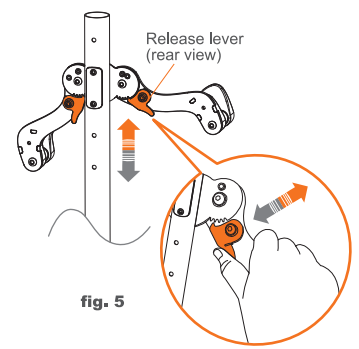
**3. Assemble Upper Hanger to Upper Post**

**5. Adjust Hanger Arms**



1. Take one of the legs, align its two bolt holes with holes in base of post. Insert long bolts and attach nuts, screwing on tightly with both Allen key and wrench. Repeat for both other legs (fig. 1).
2. Take one hanger. Choose two of the five holes on lower post. Insert 2 long bolts in hanger, fit backing plate on rear of post—align with holes and assemble. Tighten (fig. 2). Hanger rests must face up.
3. Repeat process above (fig. 3).
4. Insert narrow section of upper post into top end of lower post. Align bolt holes, insert and tighten short bolts (fig. 4).

5. Hanger arms can be adjusted to be wider or narrower, or to raise or lower either end of bike. Remove bike. Raise a hanger arm by pulling it upward. Lower an arm by pushing in release lever at rear, and pulling down (fig. 5).
