



Carrier compatibility

Most frame-mounted touring carriers. Not compatible with seatpost-mounted carriers and some types of city bike carriers.

Mounting Panniers

Panniers are supplied with plastic panels (2 per bag); insert in side pockets on the inside of bags (see fig. 1).

Pannier bags are left and right specific (reflector swatches on bags should face rear of bicycle). Hold left pannier alongside carrier and place joining flap on carrier top. Do the same with right pannier, matching both joining flaps. Adjust width to suit carrier, then press down to firmly fasten Velcro. Inner sides of panniers should be flush with sides of carrier (see fig. 2, 3).

Fasten both bag-top buckle straps and adjust length as necessary (see fig. 4).

Thread two rear Velcro straps around rear of carrier and fasten to Velcro swatches on joining flaps. Do the same with front straps. Ensure straps are tight (see fig. 5).

Fasten side buckle straps of each bag around carrier legs and tighten (see fig. 6).

In wet or dusty conditions, rain flaps should sit on outside of panniers (see fig. 7).

Use these panniers as a set, not singularly. For better stability, pack heaviest items in bottom of panniers and distribute weight evenly. If your heel brushes panniers when pedaling, unfasten the four Velcro straps attached to carrier top move the panniers toward rear, then refasten. If the problem persists, unfasten your carrier position.

Warning

- Always ensure panniers are secure on carrier before using.
- Panniers or their contents should NOT make contact with rear wheel or drivetrain. To check this, shake bike vigorously. Repeat with panniers fully packed. If any part of pannier touches wheel or drivetrain, you may need to reconsider your carrier setup. Consult a bicycle shop for advice.
- Do not use for off-road riding.
