SIMPLE BUG HOTEL FOR KIDS

Time: Approx 15-20 min (or take your time)

Materials needed:

Make it fun! Get your kids to scour the garden for some these found materials.

- Large 21 plastic bottles cut into two cylinders.
- Found materials from the garden like sticks, pine cones, tree bark, moss, leaf litter and cardboard.
- Anything else you can find bamboo, broken tiles, broken clay pots.
- String or twine to hang the hotel.



How to make a Simple Bug Hotel.

- I. Get your kids to search the garden for found materials. Sticks, twigs, bark- get them exploring and touching nature!
- 2. Supervise your kids or pre-cut the plastic bottles down to size and shape. Cut off the top and bottom of the 2l bottle and cut the cylinder in half.
- 3. Sort your materials. Check what materials you have and arrange by size and texture we snapped our twigs in half to make them a little smaller but a variety of sizes will work! Think about making 'nooks and crannies' or small spaces where the bugs can live.
- 4. Stuff your materials into the plastic cylinders. Make it nice and cosy for the little creatures with all your materials stuffed tightly inside.
- 5. Tie some string/twine around the bottles and hang in a quiet place.
